

**Passenger Transport Statistics (PT)**  
January 2010. *Provisional data*

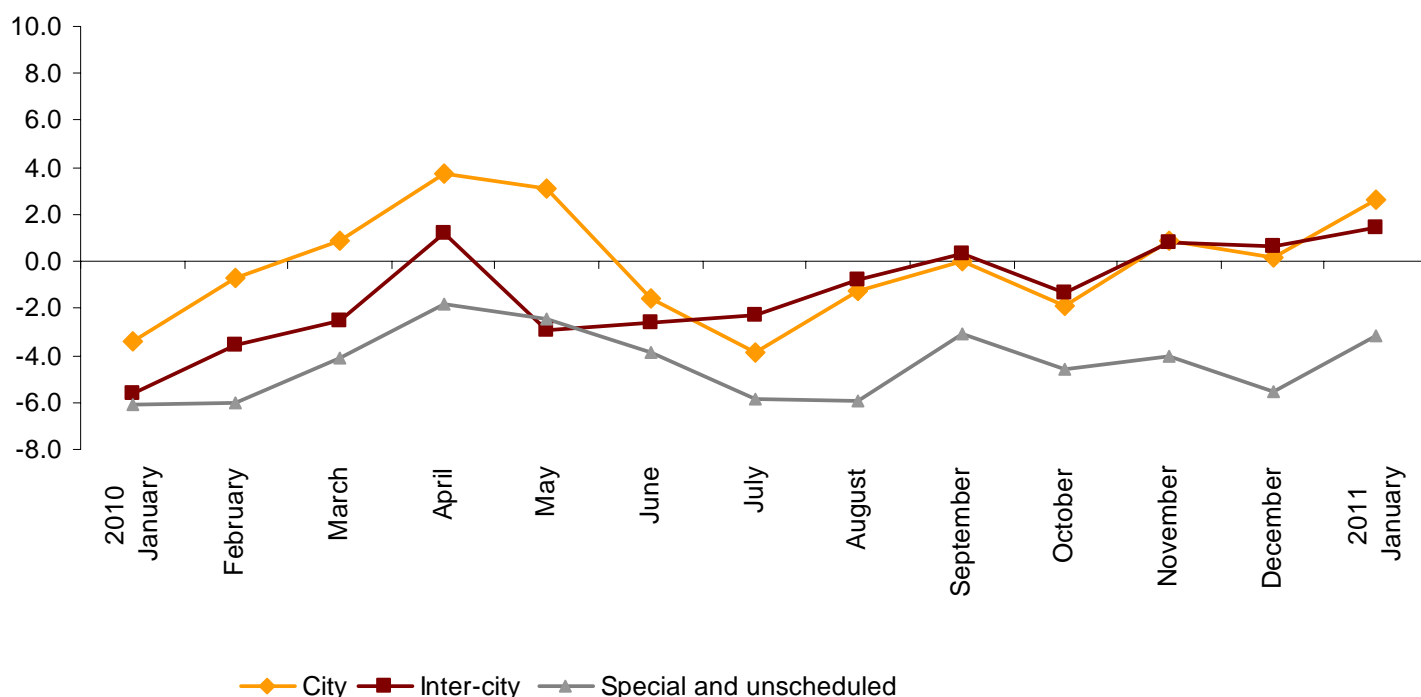
**Main results**

- The number of passengers using **city transport** increases 2.7% in January 2011, as compared with the same month the previous year.
- The **number of passengers using inter-city transport** increases 1.4% in the interannual rate.
- **Special and unscheduled transport** registers a 3.2% decrease, as compared with the same month the previous year.

**Evolution of passenger transport**

**Nearly 385 million passengers** used public transport in January 2011, that is, 1.7% more than in January 2010.

**Type of transport**

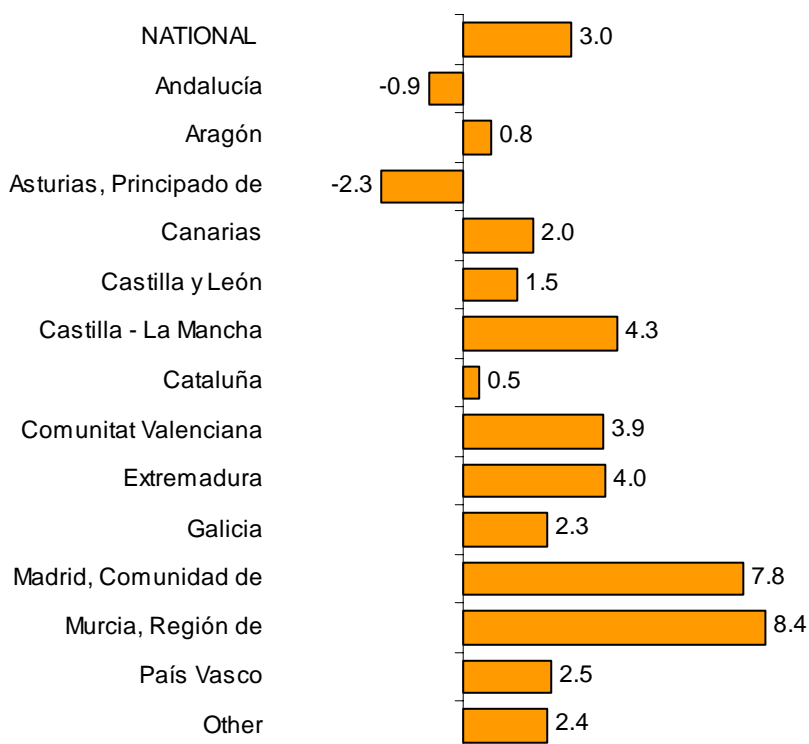


## City transport. National results and by Autonomous Community

City transport was used by more than 243 million passengers in January 2011, 2.7% more than in the same month the previous year.

Metropolitan transport increased 2.1% in the interannual rate. All of the metropolitans registered increases, except for the Madrid metropolitan (-1.3%). **This month, the INE has begun publishing the data on passengers of the Palma de Mallorca metropolitan, whose information has been collected since January 2010.**

In turn, more than 143.5 million passengers used city transport by bus, 3.0% more than in January 2010. Almost all of the Autonomous Communities presented positive rates for city transport by bus, with the increases registered in Region de Murcia (8.4%) and Comunidad de Madrid (7.8%) being of particular note. Conversely, decreases were registered in Principado de Asturias (-2.3%) and Andalucía (-0.9%).

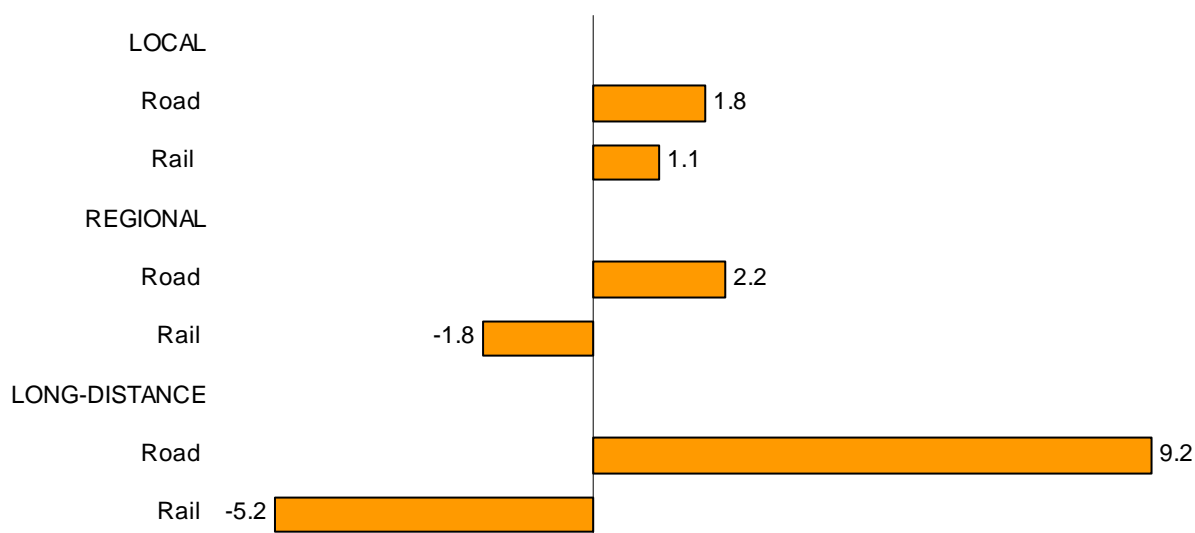
### Inter-city transport

More than 100.5 million passengers used inter-city transport in January 2011, indicating an interannual increase of 1.4%. All types of transport, except sea transport, registered a positive interannual variation. **Air** transport increased 2.7%, **road** (coach) transport increased 2.1% and **rail** transport 0.7%.

Passengers of road (coach) transport increased in the three types of transport. Long-distance passengers increased 9.2%, regional passengers increased 2.2% and local passengers rose 1.8%.

In rail transport, passengers increased 1.1% in the interannual rate in local rail transport, whereas the number of passengers decreased 5.2% for long-distance and 1.8% for regional rail transport.

### Special and unscheduled transport

More than 40.5 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in January, indicating a 3.2% decrease in the interannual rate.

Special transport passengers decreased 3.9%, standing at more than 30.5 million. Within this, both school and work transport decreased, with rates of -4.6% and -1.8%, respectively.

In turn, unscheduled transport decreased 0.7%, as compared with the same month the previous year, reaching more than 10 million passengers.
