

Passenger Transport Statistics February 2009. Provisional data

The number of passengers using city transport decreases 5% in February, as compared with the same month the previous year

The number of passengers using inter-city transport decreases 4.1% in the interannual rate

More than 259.2 million passengers used the **city bus** service in February, representing a 5% decrease with regard to the same month of 2008. Increases of 4.1% in the bus service, and 6.5% in the metropolitan service, were recorded in February.


On the other hand, **inter-city transport** was used by more than 149 million passengers, 4.1% less than the same month the previous year.



General scheduled city transport by bus decreases 4.4%

Approximately 149.5 million passengers used the general scheduled city bus this past month of February, representing a 4.4% decrease as compared with the same month of 2008.

By Autonomous Community, it is worth noting the interannual decreases registered in Extremadura (–9.4%) and Comunitat Valenciana (–8.3%).

Transport by special scheduled city bus service decreases 0.3%

During the month of February, the special scheduled city bus service experienced a decrease of 0.3% in the interannual rate. Within this, school transport registered a slight increase of 0.4%, whereas work transport decreased 2.6%.

Transport by metropolitan decreases 6.5% in the interannual rate

The number of passengers using the metropolitan decreased 6.5% in May as compared with the same month in 2008. The number of passengers transported decreased in Madrid, Barcelona and Bilbao, by 8.5%, 6.2% and 4.9%, respectively.

Inter-city transport decreases 4.1% as compared with February 2008

The number of passengers using inter-city transport exceeded 149 million during the month of February, representing an interannual decrease of 4.1%.

In transport by road, the number of passengers using the bus to commute decreased 1.2% in the interannual rate. Decreases were registered among users of scheduled transport in both cases: general scheduled (–0.6%) and special scheduled (–1.6%). Within this, the –12.6% interannual decrease in work transport was of particular note. On the other hand, discretional transport decreased 2.8% with regard to the same month from the previous year.

Rail transport registered a rate of -9.2%, due to the decrease in users of local rail. Conversely, sea transport passengers increased, registering a 3.9% increase in February.
