#### Passenger Transport Statistics (PT)

April 2012. Provisional data

#### Main results


- The number of passengers using **city transport decreases 4.5%** in April 2012, as compared with the same month the previous year.
- The number of passengers using city transport decreases 4.8% and inter-city transport decreases 3.0%.
- Special and unscheduled transport decreases a 6.7%, as compared with the same month the previous year.

#### **Passengers transport evolution**

Nearly 375 million passengers used public transport in April, 4.5% less than the same month the previous year.

The average rate of the total passengers decreased 1.7% for the first four months of the year, as compared with the same period of the previous year. By type of transport, all types presented negative average rates during this period.

#### City transport. National results and by Autonomous Community


City transport was used by 229.6 million passengers in April, 4.8% less than the same month of the previous year.

Metropolitan transport decreased 4.1% in its interannual rate. All metropolitans registered drops in their interannual rates, except Sevilla and Palma, which registered an increases of 20.9% and 10.4%, respectively.

City transport by bus decreased 5.3% in the interannual rate, with 134.9 million passengers in April.

All Autonomous Community, except Region de Murcia (3.5%) and Andalucia (0.1%), registered negative rates in city transport by bus in April. The higher interannual rates decreases were Castilla y Leon (-8.9%) and Comunitat Valenciana (-8.6%).

# Annual rates and number of passangers average Urban transport by road




#### Inter-city transport

Nearly 102.6 million passengers used inter-city transport in April, indicating an interannual decrease of 3.0%.

All types of transport registered decreases in April, except **sea** transport that registered an increase of 4.9%. **Air** transport registered a decrease of 14.1%, **road** transport (coach) decrease 3.2% and **rail** transport decrease 2.1%.

Local distance passengers decreased 4.3% for bus transport, and 1.6% for rail transport. Regional passengers distance decreased 6.5% for rail transport and 1.6% for bus transport. Finally, long-distance passengers increased 3.7% in bus transport and decreased 6.6% in rail transport.

#### Special and unscheduled transport

More than 42.7 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in April, indicating a decrease of 6.7% in the interannual rate.

Special transport passengers decreased 5.0%, reaching 28.7 million. Within this, school transport decreased 6.1% and work 1.7%.

In turn, unscheduled transport decreased 9.9%, as compared with the same month the previous year, exceeding 14 million passengers.
