Passenger Transport Statistics (PT)

May 2017. Provisional data

The number of passengers using public transport increases by 3.9% in May, as compared with the same month of the previous year


City transport increases by 5.1% in the annual rate and inter-city transport by 2.2%

Evolution of passenger transport

More than 439.3 million passengers used public transport in May, 3.9% more than in the same month of 2016.

City transport increased by 5.1% in the annual rate and inter-city transport did so by 2.2%. Within the last one, air transport was the one that recorded the greatest increase, with a 5.8% rate.

Annual evolution of passengers transport Type of transport





Evolution of the monthly rate

The variation rate of the number of passengers of public transport in May as compared with April was 14.9%. To contribute to the analysis and interpretation of data, the evolution of the monthly rate of public transport passengers in the last years is shown in the following chart.

Evolution of the monthly rate (month-on-month variation for May as compared with April)




City transport

City transport was used by more than 267.8 million passengers in May, 5.1% more than in the same month of 2016.

The subway transport increased by 5.8% and grows in all the cities. Sevilla's subway had the largest increase (42.5%).

All cities with metro transport registered positive rates for bus transport. The highest increase was registered in Valencia (11.9%).

Annual rate of city transport passengers in major cities with Metro





City transport by bus increased by 4.7% with regards to the same month of the previous year.

All Autonomous Communities registered negative annual rates. The greatest increases were registered Extremadura (8.9%), Aragón (8.8%) and Cataluña (8.3%).

In turn, the lowest increases were registered in Comunidad de Madrid (1.4%), Comunitat Valenciana (2.2%) and Galicia (2.9%).

Inter-city transport


More than 117.5 million passengers used inter-city transport in May, representing a 2.2% increase as compared with the same month of 2016.

By type of transport, by air increased by 5.8%, maritime transport by 4.2%, rail by 2.2%, and bus transport increased by 1.9%.

Cercanías increased bus transport by 2.0%, and rail transport by 2.4%. The average distance grew 1.5% for bus transport, but decreased be 1.4% for rail transport.

Finally, long distance passengers increased by 2.0% for bus transport and by 3.3% for rail transport. Within the last one, AVE (high speed railway) increased by 3.5%.

Special and unscheduled transport

More than 53.9 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in May, indicating an increase of 1.8% in the annual rate.

The number of special transport passengers decreased by 0.2%, reaching more than 33.6 million users. Within this, school transport increased by 1.7%, while work transport decreased by 7.5%.

In turn, unscheduled transport increased 5.5%, as compared with the same month of 2016, reaching more than 20.3 million passengers.
