

Passenger Transport Statistics (PT) July 2012. *Provisional data*

Main results

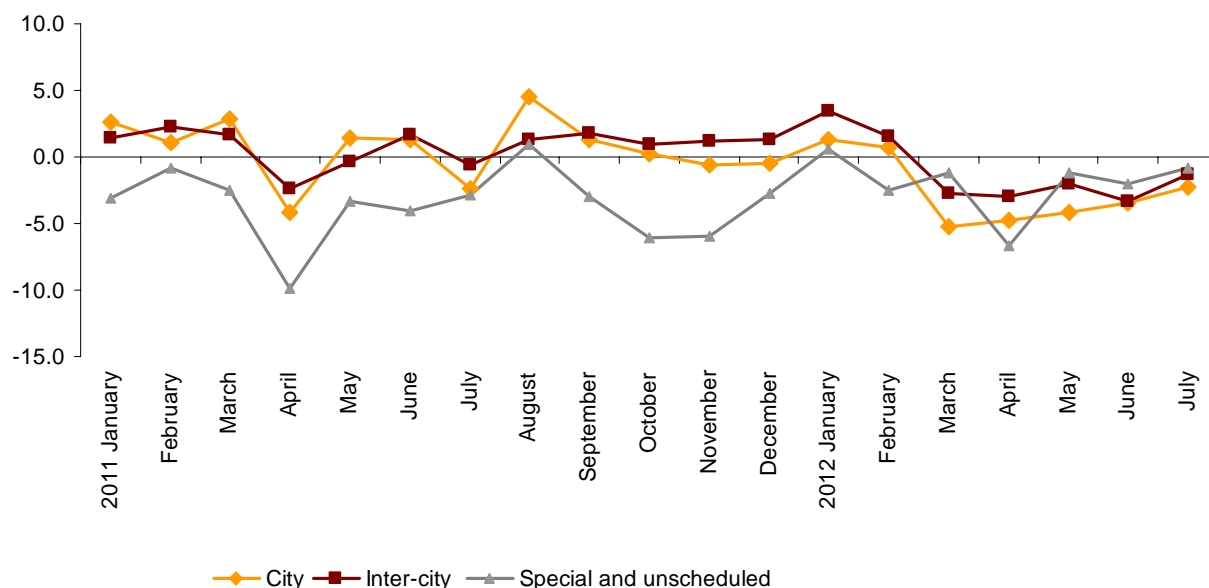
- The number of passengers using **city transport decreases 1.9%** in July 2012, as compared with the same month the previous year.
- The month-on-month variation for July as compared with June was **-12.3%**. This rate was higher than the one registered in July last year.
- The number of passengers using city transport decreases 2.2% in the interannual rate and inter-city transport decreases 1.3%.
- Special and unscheduled transport decreases a 0.8%, as compared with the same month the previous year.

Passengers transport evolution

More than 350.8 million passengers used public transport in July, 1.9% less than the same month the previous year.

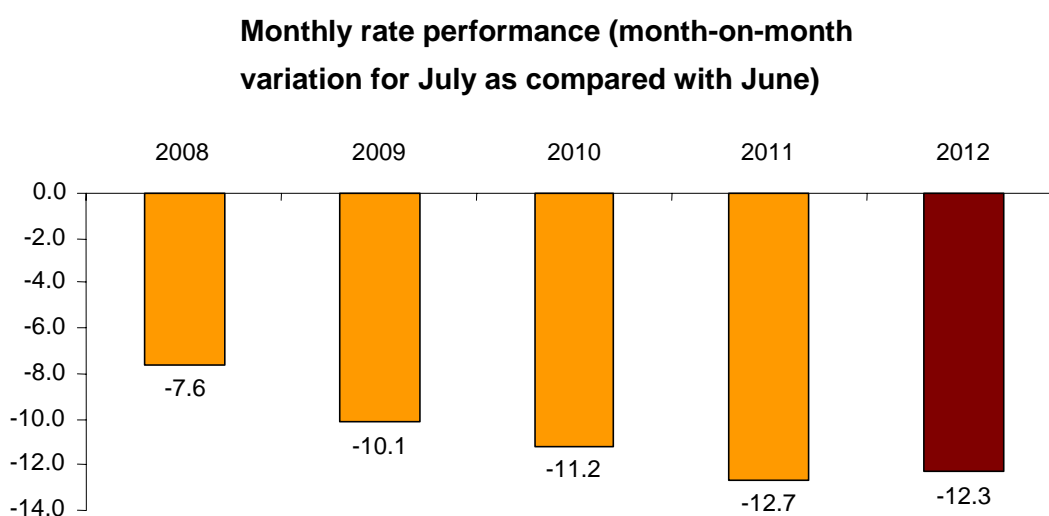
The average number of the total passengers decreased 2.1% for the first seven months of the year, as compared with the same period of the previous year. By type of transport, all types presented negative average rates during this period.

Monthly rate performance¹

The variation rate for the number of passengers on public transport in July as compared with June 2012 was -12.3% . This month-on-month rate was four tenths higher than that registered last year.



¹ In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of data, this section has been added with performance of the monthly rate for the number of users of public transport in July for recent years. The month-on-month rates of this type of series may have some degree of seasonal behaviour, therefore it is recommended that it be evaluated in relation to the item of data for the same month in previous years.

City transport. National results and by Autonomous Community

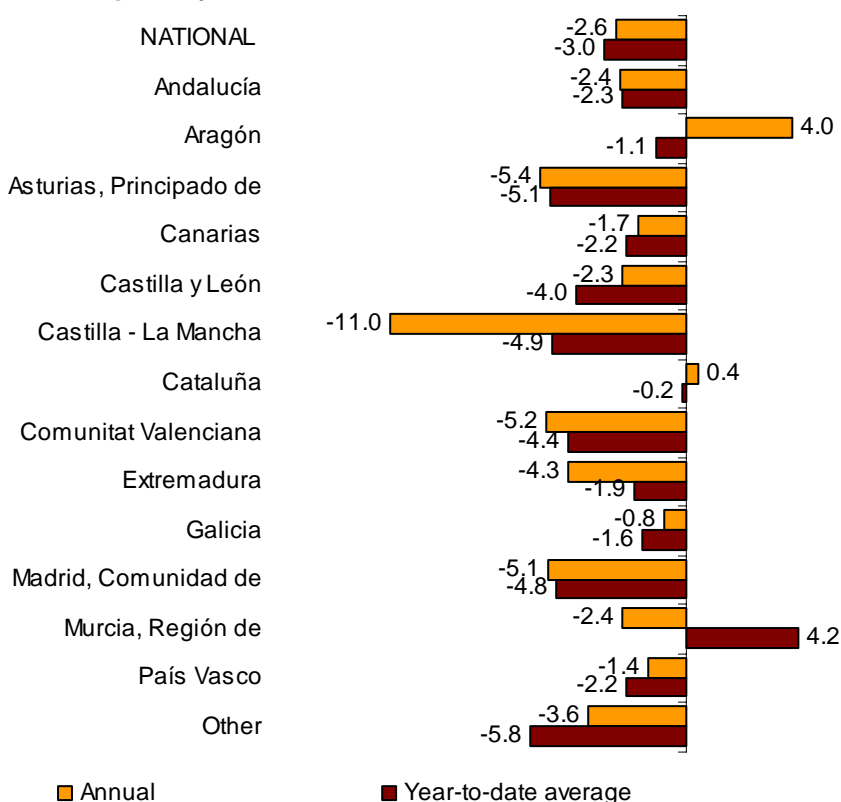
City transport was used by more than 218.8 million passengers in July, 2.2% less than the same month of the previous year.

Metropolitan transport decreased 1.7% in its interannual rate. All metropolitans registered drops in their interannual rates, except Valencia and Bilbao, which registered increases of 5.0% and 1.6%, respectively.

City transport by bus decreased 2.6% in the interannual rate, with almost 129.8 million passengers in July.

All Autonomous Community, except Aragón (4.0%) and Cataluña (0.4%), registered negative rates in city transport by bus in July. The higher interannual rate decrease was Castilla-La Mancha (-11.0%).

Annual rates and number of passengers average Urban transport by road



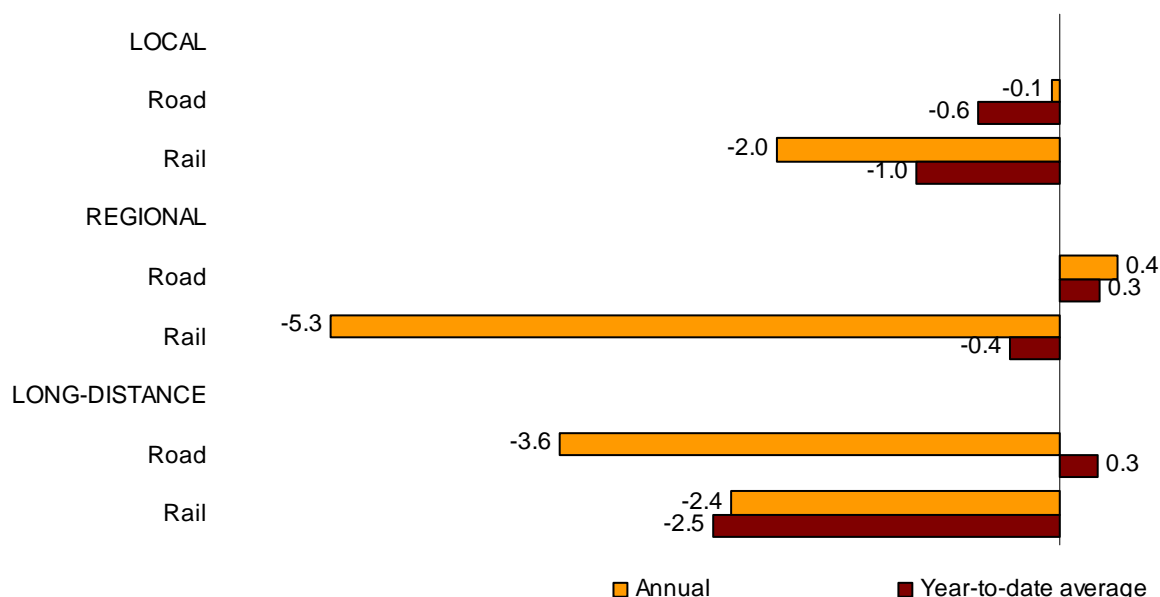
Inter-city transport

Nearly 108.8 million passengers used inter-city transport in July, indicating an interannual decrease of 1.3%.

All types of transport registered decreases in July, except **bus** transport, that almost remained as compared with the same month the previous year. **Air** transport registered a decrease of 8.6%, **rail** transport decreased 2.3% and **sea** transport decreased 0.1%.

Local distance passengers decreased 2.0% for rail transport, and 0.1% for bus transport. Regional passengers distance decreased 5.3% for rail transport and increased 0.4% for bus transport. Finally, long-distance passengers decreased 3.6% in bus transport and decreased 2.4% in rail transport.

Special and unscheduled transport

More than 23.2 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in July, indicating a decrease of 0.8% in the interannual rate.

Special transport passengers increased 3.0%, standing at more than 8.3 million. Within this, work transport increased 3.8% and school decreased 3.7%.

In turn, unscheduled transport decreased 2.8%, as compared with the same month the previous year, reaching more than 14.9 million passengers.
