Passenger Transport Statistics (PT) October 2012. Provisional data


The number of passengers using city transport decreases 0.5% in October, as compared with the same month the previous year

The city transport decreases 1.2% in the annual rate and the inter-city transport increases 0.5%

Passengers transport evolution


Nearly 423.6 million passengers used public transport in October, 0.5% less than the same month the previous year.

The average number of the total passengers decreased 2.7% for the first ten months of the year, as compared with the same period of the previous year. All types presented negative average rates during this period.



Monthly rate performance¹

The variation rate for the number of passengers on public transport in October as compared with September 2012 was 16.8%. This monthly rate was the highest in the last five year.



City transport. National results and by Autonomous Community

City transport was used by more than 257.3 million passengers in October, 1.2% less than the same month the previous year.

Metropolitan transport registered a 1.7% decrease in its annual rate. All metropolitans registered negative rates, except the metropolitans of Bilbao and Palma, that presented a 2.0% and 18.0% increase. The metropolitan of Valencia was the higher decrease, with a variation of -4.9%.


City transport by bus decreased 0.9% in the annual rate, with 153.8 million passengers in October.

¹ In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of data, this section has been added with performance of the monthly rate for the number of users of public transport in October for recent years. The month-on-month rates of this type of series may have some degree of seasonal behaviour, therefore it is recommended that it be evaluated in relation to the item of data for the same month in previous years.

By Autonomous Community, the greatest increases were registered in Extremadura (6.3%) and Galicia (5.1%).

In turn, Castilla-La Mancha presented the highest decrease (-9.8%).

Inter-city transport


More than 116.2 million passengers used inter-city transport in October, indicating a 0.5% decrease as compared with the same month of 2011.

The **bus** transport is the only transport that presented positive annual variation (2.1%). In turn, **air** transport decreased 14.2% and **rail** transport dropped 0.3%.

Local distance passengers remained for rail transport, and increased 2.8% for bus transport. Regional passengers distance decreased 5.4% for rail transport and increased 0.6% for bus transport.

Finally, long-distance passengers increased 1.2% in rail transport and 0.6% in bus transport.

Special and unscheduled transport

Nearly 50 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in October, indicating a 1.2% increase in the annual rate.

Special transport passengers increased 4.9%, standing at almost 36 million. Within this, school transport increased 5.8% and work 1.7%.

In turn, unscheduled transport decreased 7.1%, as compared with the same month the previous year, reaching more than 14 million passengers.
