Passenger Transport Statistics November 2008. Provisional data

The number of passengers using city transport decreases 2% in November as compared with the same month of the previous year

The number of passengers using inter-city transport decreases 1.3% in the interannual rate

More than 274 million passengers used **city transport** in November, representing a 2.0% decrease with regard to the same month of 2007. Decreases of -2.3% in the bus service and -1.4% in the metropolitan service were recorded in November.

On the other hand, **inter-city transport** was used by more 161 million passengers, that is, 1.3% less than during the same month of the previous year.



General scheduled city transport by bus decreases 2.4%

More than 158.4 million passengers used the general scheduled city bus this past month of November, representing a decrease of 2.4% as compared with the same month of 2007.

By Autonomous Community, it is worth noting the interannual increase registered in Canarias (3.2%) and the decrease registered in Murcia (-7.5%).

Transport by special scheduled city bus increases 1.2%

During the month of November, the special scheduled city bus service experienced an increase of 1.2% in the interannual rate. Within this, the special scheduled school bus service registered an increase of 2.9%, while the special scheduled work bus service experienced a decrease of 3.7%.

Transport by metropolitan decreases 1.4% in the interannual rate

The number of passengers using the metropolitan decreased 1.4% in November as compared with the same month in 2007. An increase was recorded in Valencia (3.4%), while the Barcelona, Madrid and Bilbao metropolitan services presented decreases of 2.7%, 1.3% and 0.8%, respectively.

Inter-city transport decreases 1.3% as compared with November 2007

The number of passengers using inter-city transport exceeded 161.6 million persons during the month of November, representing an interannual decrease of 1.3%.

In road transport, the number of passengers using the bus to commute decreased 1.5% in the interannual rate. A decrease was registered among the users of general scheduled transport (-1.4%), whereas the passengers using special scheduled transport experienced a slight increase of 0.1%. In turn, non-scheduled transport decreased 6.2% as compared with the same month the previous year.

Air transport suffered a significant drop of 19.5% in the interannual rate, with respect to November 2007.
