### Passenger Transport Statistics (PT)

November 2011. Provisional data

#### Main results


- The number of passengers using **city transport decreases 0.6%** in November 2011, as compared with the same month the previous year.
- The number of passengers using **inter-city transport increases 1.1%** in the interannual rate.
- Special and unscheduled transport decreases a 5.9%, as compared with the same month the previous year.

#### **Passengers transport evolution**

**Nearly 420 million passengers** used public transport in November, 0.8% less than the same month the previous year.

In the first eleven months of 2011, the average number of total passenger increases 0.3%, as compared with the same period of the previous year. By type of transport, all classes presented positive average rates in this period, except special and unscheduled transport that decreased 3.8%.

#### City transport. National results and by Autonomous Community


City transport was used by more than 256.6 million passengers in November, 0.6% less than the same month of the previous year.

Metropolitan transport decreased 1.2% in its interannual rate. All of the metropolitans registered negative interannual rates, except Sevilla metropolitan that recorded an increase of 3.2%. Whereas the Palma, Vlencia, Bilbao, Barcelona and Madrid metropolitan registered negative rates of –8.2%, -7.2%, -2.4%, -1.8% and –0.1% respectively.

City transport by bus decreased 0.3% in the interannual rate, with more than 152.7 million passengers in November.

The half of Autonomous Community registered negative rates in November. The higher interannual rates drops were Principado de Asturias (-2.6%), Others (-1.8%) and Andalucía (-1.6%). Conversely, País Vasco (3.9%) and Galicia (3.0%) presented the higher increases.

# Annual rates and number of passangers average Urban transport by road




#### Inter-city transport

More than 113.3 million passengers used inter-city transport in November, indicating an interannual increase of 1.1%.

**Sea** transport registered an increase of 9.5% and **rail** transport an increase of 3.4%. Conversely, **air** transport experienced a decrease of 7.0% and **road** transport (coach) decreases 0.5% in its interannual rate.

Local distance passengers increased 4.2% for rail transport, and 1.1% for bus transport. Regional passengers distance decreased in both types of transport (8.5% for rail and 3.6% for bus). On the other hand, long-distance passengers increased 3.9% in rail transport and decreased 2.9% in road transport.

#### Special and unscheduled transport

Almost 50 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in November, indicating a decrease of 5.9% in the interannual rate.

Special transport passengers decreased 7.7%, reaching more than 36.2 million. Within this, both school and work transport decreased, with rates of –8.3% and –5.7%, respectively.

In turn, unscheduled transport decreased 0.6%, as compared with the same month the previous year, exceeding 13.5 million passengers.
