#### **Passenger Transport Statistics (PT)**


December 2011. Provisional data

#### Main results

- The number of passengers using **public transport decreases 0.2%** in December 2011, as compared with the same month the previous year.
- The number of passengers using city transport decreases 0.5% in the interannual rate, whereas inter-city transport increases 1.4%.
- Special and unscheduled transport registered a decrease of 2.7% in December
- In the year 2010, the total number of users of public transport register an increase of 0.3%.

**Nearly 388 million passengers** used public transport in December 2011, 0.2% less than in December 2010.

# Annual evolution of passenger transport Type of transport



In the year 2011, the public transport resgistered an increase of 0.3%, as compared with 2010. By type of transport, all classes presented positive average rates in this period, except special and unscheduled transport that decreased 3.7%.

#### City transport. National results and by Autonomous Community

City transport was used by more than 243 million passengers in December, indicating an interannual decrease of 0.5%..

Metropolitan transport decreased 1.1% in its interannual rate. All of the metropolitans registered decreases, except Sevilla metropolitan (6.8%) and Madrid metropolitan (0.1%).


In the year 2011, metropolitan transport increased 1.3%, as compared with the year 2010.

In turn, city transport by bus was used by almost 143 million passengers in December, figure similar to the same month of 2010.

By Autonomous Community, the greatest increases in passengers were registered in Comunitat Valenciana (2.7%) and Galicia (2.4%). The greatest decrease was in Asturias (-5.8%).

In the year 2011, city transport by bus registered a 0.1% increase.

# Annual rates and number of passangers average Urban transport by road




#### **Inter-city transport**

More than 104.7 million passengers used inter-city transport in December, indicating an interannual increase of 1.4%. **Rail** transport and **Road** (coach) transport experienced a positive interannual variation of 2.3% and 0.8%, respectively. In turn, **Air** transport and **sea** transport registered decreases of 1.5% and 1.0%, respectively.

Local distance passengers increased in both types of transport (1.9% for bus transport, and 1.4% for rail transport). Regional passengers distance increased a 22.3% in rail and decreased a 1.7% in bus transport. In turn, long-distance passengers decreased in both types of transport (1.8% in rail transport and 0.1% in bus transport).

In the year 2011, inter-city transport registered an increase of 1.2%. All of type of transport experienced increases, except air transport.

#### Special and unscheduled transport

Almost 40 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in December, indicating a decrease of 2.7% in the interannual rate, as compared with the same month of 2010.

Special transport passengers decreased 2.9%. With decreases of both, the school (-2.9%) and work transport (-2.7%).

In turn, unscheduled transport decreased 2.5% in December.

In the year 2011, Special and unscheduled transport registered a decrease of 3.7%, as compared with the previous year.
