December 2012. Provisional data

The number of passengers using city transport decreases 7.7% in December, as compared with the same month of the previous year


The city transport decreases 8.8% in the annual rate and the inter-city transport decreases 6.4%

Passengers transport performance

Nearly 356.7 million passengers used public transport in December, 7.7% less than the same month of the previous year.

The average number of the total passengers decreased 3.5% in 2012, as compared with 2011. All types of transport presented negative average rates during this year.

Annual performance of passenger transport Type of transport







Monthly rate performance¹

City transport. National results and by Autonomous Community


City transport was used by more than 222.3 million passengers in December, 8.8% less than the same month the previous year.


Metropolitan transport registered a 10.1% decrease in its annual rate. All metropolitans registered negative rates, except for that in Palma, which registered an increase of 14.4%. The metropolitan of Valencia was the highest decrease (–13.0%).

City transport by bus decreased 7.9% in the annual rate, with almost 132 million passengers in December.

By Autonomous Community, the greatest decreases were registered in Castilla-La Mancha (-17.9%), Región de Murcia (-12.8%) and Galicia (-12.5%).

Inter-city transport


More than 97.6 million passengers used inter-city transport in December, indicating a 6.4% decrease as compared with the same month of 2011.

All types of transport presented negative annual variations. The **air** transport registered a drop of 18.2%. In turn, **bus** transport decreased 8.2% and **rail** transport 3.8%.

Local distance passengers decreased 9.0% for bus transport, and 3.1% for rail transport. Regional passengers distance decreased 12.8% for rail transport and 6.3% for bus transport.

Finally, long-distance passengers decreased 10.1% in bus transport and 5.1% in rail transport.

Special and unscheduled transport

Nearly 36.8 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in December, indicating a 3.7% decrease in the annual rate.

Special transport passengers decreased 1.4%, reaching more than 26.6 million. Within this, work transport decreased 2.8% and school transport, 0.9%.

In turn, unscheduled transport decreased 9.3%, as compared with the same month the previous year, reaching more than 10.1 million passengers.
