### Retail Trade Indices. Base 2005 January 2010. Provisional data

#### **Main Results**

- The **General Retail Trade Index** registers an **interannual variation of -4.5%** in January, at constant prices. After adjusting for the calendar effect, the interannual rate stands at -2.8%.
- All of the distribution classes present negative annual rates. Large chain stores present the smallest drop, with a rate of -0.7%.
- **Employment** in the retail sector **decreases 2.7%** as compared with January 2009.
- Retail sales at constant prices present **negative interannual rates** in all of the **Autonomous Communities**. Employment also registers a generalised decrease in all of the Autonomous Communities, except in Extremadura (0.1%).

#### **Evolution of trade, in general and by type of product**


Sales in retail trade at constant prices (that is, after eliminating the prices' effect) registered an interannual rate of **-4.5%** in January 2010, indicating a decrease of more than three points as compared with the rate from December.

Sales, without service stations, presented an annual rate of **-3.3%** in constant terms. The breakdown of these sales, by type of product, showed a decrease of 3.1% in food products and a drop of 3.3% in non-food products. Among the latter, the products that registered the most pronounced drop were those relating to Household equipment, with an annual rate of -6.8%.

In turn, sales in service stations, after adjusting for the prices' effect, decreased 9.5% in January, as compared with the same month of 2009.

### **Evolution of trade, by distribution class**

Deflated retail trade presented negative interannual variation rates in all of the distribution classes.

Small chain stores presented the greatest decrease in sales (-5.4%), whilst Large chain stores registered the smallest decrease (with an annual rate of -0.7%).

### **Department stores. Variation rates**


The *Department Store Index*, which reflects the behaviour of sales in premises larger than 2,500m2, registered an interannual decrease of **2.6%**, in constant terms, in January. This decrease in sales was more pronounced in food products (-7.9%) than in non-food products (-0.5%).

### Evolution of trade, adjusted for the calendar effect

After eliminating the calendar effect, that is, the difference between the number of working days in a given month in different years, the General Retail Trade Index at constant prices registered a variation of **-2.8%** in January, over the same month the previous year. This rate was more than half a point lower than that registered in December 2009.




### **Evolution of employment, by distribution class**

The Retail Trade Employment Index, which shows the evolution of both paid and unpaid employment, registered an annual rate of **-2.7%** in January. This implied an increase of seven tenths over the rate from December.

Employment decreased in all of the distribution classes. *Department stores*, with an annual rate of -4.7%, presented the greatest drop.

In Service Stations, employment was 1.4% lower than that for January 2009.

### Annual employment rates, by distribution class




### Autonomous Communities. Annual variation rates of sales

In January 2010, all of the Autonomous Communities experienced a decrease in retail trade sales at constant prices. Andalucía (-7.3%), Illes Balears (-6.9%) and País Vasco (-6.6%) presented the greatest drops.

Galicia, with an annual rate of -0.3%, was the Autonomous Community with the smallest decrease in sales.

Annual rates at constant prices




### **Autonomous Communities. Annual employment variation rates**

Employment in retail trade in January presented a generalised decrease in all of the Autonomous Communities, except in Extremadura (whose interannual rate was 0.1%).

Illes Balears and Región de Murcia registered the greatest drops in employment (both with a rate of -4.8%).

### Methodological note

#### New deflators in the Retail Trade Indices

Each month, the National Statistics Institute publishes the Retail Trade Indices at constant prices, whose objective is to show the evolution of retail sector sales after adjusting for the prices' effect.

The adaptation to the new Classification of Economic Activities (CNAE 2009), with the inclusion of service stations within division 47 (*retail trade*), has made it necessary to revise the deflators used until now, in such a way that they adapt better to the products that each one of the retail trade indices published contains.

As of January 2010, the price indices used to deflate the values of retail trade sales are as follows:

- General CPI excluding services and rentals; and excluding motor vehicles, other vehicles, spare parts and accessories for maintenance.
- General CPI excluding services and rentals; and excluding motor vehicles, other vehicles, spare parts and accessories for maintenance; and excluding fuels and lubricants for personal transport equipment.
- General CPI excluding food, beverages and tobacco; and excluding services and rentals; and excluding motor vehicles, other vehicles, spare parts and accessories for maintenance; and excluding fuels and lubricants for personal transport equipment.

The indices at constant prices obtained with the new deflators reflect, more precisely, the variation in real terms that is registered in the retail sector, by eliminating the variation in prices occurring in the items collected in each one of the indicators.

The listing of the price indices used as a deflator in each retail trade index may be viewed in INEbase (www.ine.es.). Moreover, in order to guarantee the comparability of the information over time, the retrospective series with the new deflators are also available on the INE website from January 2002 onwards, except the distribution class series, which began in the year 2005.
