Retail Trade Indices (RTI). Base 2005 March 2010. Provisional data

Main Results

- The General Retail Trade Index registers an interannual variation of 3.5% in March, at constant prices, this being the first positive rate since February 2008. After adjusting for the calendar effect, the interannual rate stands at 2.1%.
- The average rate of retail sales stands at -0.8% in the first quarter of the year.
- All of the distribution classes present positive annual rates. Large chain stores present the greatest increase, with a rate of 9.3%.
- Employment in the retail sector decreases 2.3% as compared with March 2009.
- Retail sales at constant prices present positive interannual rates in almost all of the Autonomous Communities. Employment only increases in two Communities.

Evolution of trade in general, and by type of product


Sales in retail trade at constant prices (that is, after eliminating the prices' effect) registered an interannual rate of **3.5%** in March 2010, indicating an increase of more than four points as compared with February.

Sales, excluding service stations, presented an annual rate, in constant terms, of **5.3%**. The breakdown of these sales by type of product showed an increase of 4.6% in food products and 5.8% in non-food products. Among the latter, Personal Equipment was that which increased the most, with a rate of 7.3%.

In turn, sales in service stations, after adjusting for the prices' effect, decreased 5.8% in March, as compared with the same month of 2009.

The average rate of General Retail Trade Index for the first quarter of the year decreased -**0.8%** as compared with the first quarter the previous year, increasing more than two points over the average rate of the first two months of the year.

Evolution of trade, by distribution class

All of the distribution classes experienced increases in sales as compared with the same month the previous year. *Large chain stores* (9.3%) and *Department stores* (7.7%) were the distribution classes that presented the greatest increases.

In the first quarter, *Large chain stores* and *Department stores* presented positive average rates, whereas *Small chain stores* and *Single retail stores* recorded decreases in sales as compared with the same quarter the previous year.



Evolution of trade, adjusted for the calendar effect

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After eliminating the calendar effect, that is, the difference between the number of working days in a given month in different years, the General Retail Trade Index at constant prices registered a variation of **2.1%** in March, over the same month the previous year. This rate increased more than three points as compared with that registered in February 2010. This was the first positive rate since November 2007.



Evolution of employment, by distribution class

The Retail Trade Employment Index registered an annual rate of **-2.3%** in March, equal to the rate recorded in February.

Employment decreased in all of the distribution classes. *Small chain stores* (-4.0%) and *Department stores* (-3.4%) presented the greatest decreases. In *Service stations*, employment decreased –1.5% as compared with March 2009.

In the retail sector group, the average employment rate decreased -2.4% in the first quarter of the year as compared with the same period the previous year.





Results by Autonomous Community. Variation rates in sales

In March 2010, all of the Autonomous Communities experienced a increase in retail trade sales at constant prices, except Andalucía (-0.1%) and Illes Balears (-1.2%).

Castilla y León (8.0%) and Principado de Asturias (6.9%) were the Communities that registered the greatest increases.






Results by Autonomous Community. Employment variation rates

Employment in retail trade in March presented positive rates in the Communities of Principado de Asturias (1.0%) and Castilla y León (0.6%).

Illes Balears (-4.5%) and Comunidad de Madrid (-4.0%) registered the greatest decreases in employment.
