**Industrial Production Index. Base 2005
February 2009**

**The Industrial Production Index adjusted for calendar effects
decreases 22.0% in February, as compared with the same month in
2008**

The General Industrial Production Index (IPI) experienced a -23.9% variation in February 2009, in comparison with the same month the previous year.

After adjusting for calendar effects, the interannual rate of the IPI was estimated at -22.0%.

By economic destination of the goods, the variation rates as compared with the same month of the previous year were -13.5% for Consumer goods (-33.1% for Durable consumer goods and -10.0% for Non-durable consumer goods), -32.2% for Capital goods, -31.7% for Intermediate goods and -9.6% for Energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these interannual rates were estimated at -11.0% for Consumer goods (-29.7% for Durable consumer goods and -7.7% for Non-durable consumer goods), -30.2% for Capital goods, -29.6% for Intermediate goods and -9.0% for Energy.

**The average rate of the IPI adjusted for calendar effects decreases 21.5% in the
interannual rate during the first two months in 2009**

The average rate of the IPI stood at -24.1% during the first two months of 2009, as compared with the same period in 2008. After adjusting for calendar effects, this average rate stood at -21.5%.

The evolution of the average industrial production rate by economic destination of the goods was -15.4% for Consumer goods (-34.1% for Durable consumer goods and -12.1% for Non-durable consumer goods), -33.0% for Capital goods, -32.2% for Intermediate goods and -6.4% for Energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these average rates for the first two months stood at -12.0% for Consumer goods (-29.5% for Durable consumer goods and -8.9% for Non-durable consumer goods), -30.4% for Capital goods, -29.4% for Intermediate goods and -5.6% for Energy.

The only activity that experienced an increase during the January-February period was *Mining of coal and lignite*, with a rate of 6.6%.

In contrast, those with the greatest decreases were *Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers*, with -54.0%, *Manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products*, with -43.5%, and *Other mining and quarrying*, with -41.8%.
