Industrial Production Index. Base 2005 June 2009

The Industrial Production Index adjusted for calendar effects decreases 16.2% in June, as compared with the same month in 2008

The General Industrial Production Index (IPI) experienced a -14.5% variation in June 2009, as compared with the same month the previous year.

After adjusting for calendar effects, the interannual rate of the IPI was estimated at -16.2%.

By economic destination of the goods, the variation rates as compared with the same month the previous year were -4.7% for Consumer goods (-30.7% for Durable consumer goods and -0.1% for Non-durable consumer goods), -22.2% for Capital goods, -19.4% for Intermediate goods and -7.8% for Energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these interannual rates were estimated at -7.0% for Consumer goods (-33.7% for Durable consumer goods and -2.3% for Non-durable consumer goods), -24.0% for Capital goods, -21.3% for Intermediate goods and -8.4% for Energy.

The average rate of the IPI adjusted for calendar effects decreases 20.7% in the interannual rate during the first six months of 2009

The average rate of the IPI stood at -21.5% during the first six months of 2009, as compared with the same period in 2008. After adjusting for calendar effects, this average rate stood at -20.7%.

The evolution of the average industrial production rate by economic destination of the goods was -12.2% for Consumer goods (-32.8% for Durable consumer goods and -8.5% for Non-durable consumer goods), -28.3% for Capital goods, -28.6% for Intermediate goods and -9.4% for Energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these average rates for the first six months stood at –11.2% for Consumer goods (-31.5% for Durable consumer goods and –7.5% for Non-durable consumer goods), -27.5% for Capital goods, –27.8 for Intermediate goods and –9.4% for Energy.

The activities that experienced less significant decreases during the January-June 2009 period were *Manufacture of food products*, with -1.7% and *Manufacture of basic pharmaceutical products*, with -2.2%.

Conversely, those activities with the greatest decreases were *Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers,* with –43.7%, and *Other mining and quarrying*, with –35.2%.
