Industrial Production Index. Base 2000 July 2008

The Industrial Production Index adjusted for calendar effects decreases 4.4% in July as compared to the same month in 2007

The General Industrial Production Index (IPI) experienced a -3.0% variation in July 2008 in comparison with the same month the previous year. After adjusting for calendar effects, the interannual variation of the IPI was estimated at -4.4%.

By economic destination of the goods, the variation rates with respect to the same month from the previous year were -1.8% for consumer goods (-14.4% for durable consumer goods and 0.7% for non-durable consumer goods), -0.7% for capital goods, -7.0% for intermediate goods and 2.2% for energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these interannual rates were estimated at -3.6% for consumer goods (-16.6% for durable consumer goods and -1.1% for non-durable consumer goods), -2.2% for capital goods, -8.5% for intermediate goods and 1.7% for energy.

The average rate of the IPI adjusted for calendar effects decreases 3.0% in the first seven months of 2008

The average IPI rate stood at -3.1% during the first seven months of 2008 as compared with the same period of 2007. After adjusting for calendar effects, this average rate stood at -3.0%.

The evolution of the average industrial production rate by economic destination of the goods was -3.3% for consumer goods (-10.1% for durable consumer goods and -2.1% for non-durable consumer goods), -0.9% for capital goods, -6.3% for intermediate goods and 3.3% for energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these average rates for the seven first months stood at -3.3% for consumer goods (-10.1% for durable consumer goods and -2.0% for non-durable consumer goods), -0.9% for capital goods, -6.2% for intermediate goods and 3.4% for energy.

The activities with the greatest growth in the January-July 2008 period were *Manufacture of electronic material; manufacture of radio, television and communication equipment and apparatus*, with 22.2%, and *Manufacture of other transport material*, with 7.9%.

In contrast, those with the lowest growth were *Manufacture of office machines and IT equipment*, with -25.9%, and *Manufacture of wood and cork, except furniture; manufacture of articles of straw and plaiting materials*, with -16.8%.
