Industrial Production Index. Base 2005 July 2009

The Industrial Production Index adjusted for calendar effects decreases 17.4% in July as compared with the same month in 2008

The General Industrial Production Index (IPI) experienced a -16.7% variation in July 2009 in comparison with the same month the previous year.

After adjusting for calendar effects, the interannual rate of the IPI registered a decrease of -17.4%.

By economic destination of the goods, the variation rates with respect to the same month the previous year were -9.8% for Consumer goods (-30.4 for Durable consumer goods and -6.2% for Non-durable consumer goods), -26.0% for Capital goods, 20.0% for Intermediate goods and -6.9% for Energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these interannual rates stood at – 10.7% for Consumer goods (-31.7% for Durable consumer goods and –7.0% for Non-durable consumer goods), -26.7% for Capital goods, –20.8% for Intermediate goods and -7.2% for Energy.

The average rate of the IPI adjusted for calendar effects decreases 20.2% in the interannual rate in the first seven months of 2009

The average IPI rate stood at -20.7% during the first seven months of 2009, in comparison with the same month of 2008. After adjusting for calendar effects, this average rate stood at -20.2%.

The evolution of the average industrial production rate by economic destination of the goods was -11.8% for Consumer goods (-32.5% for Durable consumer goods and -8.1% for Non-durable consumer goods), -28.1% for Capital goods, -27.3% for Intermediate goods and -9.0% for Energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these average rates for the first seven months stood at -11.0% for Consumer goods (-31.5% for Durable consumer goods and -7.3% for Non-durable consumer goods), -27.5% for Capital goods,— 26.7% for Intermediate goods and -9.0% for Energy.

The activities which experienced the most moderate decreases during the January-July period of 2009 were *Manufacture of pharmaceutical products*, with –0.4%, and *Food industry*, with –1.8%.

In contrast, the activities which experienced the greatest decreases were *Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers*, with –42.0%, and *Manufacture of furniture*, with –34.4%.
