

Industrial Production Index (IPI). Base 2005

July 2010. Provisional Data

Main Results

- The **Industrial Production Index** experiences an **interannual variation** in **July** of **-1.6%**, almost five points below that registered in June.
- By economic destination of the goods, all the sectors present negative interannual rates, except Energy.
- The average rate of the IPI stands at 1.4% in the first seven months of the year.
- Industrial production registers negative interannual rates in 10 Autonomous
 Communities in the month of July.

Annual evolution of Industrial Production

The Industrial Production Index (IPI) experienced an interannual variation of **-1.6%** in July, approximately five points below that recorded in June.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that most influenced the interannual decrease in industrial production in July were:

- Capital goods, with an annual rate of -6.0% and an effect of -1.214 on the general index, largely caused by the decreases observed in the *Manufacture of metal elements for construction* and the *Manufacture of other general purpose machinery n.e.c.* The contraction in the production of this sector was lessened by the repercussions in the *Manufacture of components, parts and accessories for motor vehicles* and the *Manufacture of motor vehicles*, which continued to register positive rates, although not as significant as in previous months.
- Non-durable consumer goods, with an annual rate of -1.8% and an effect of -0.501 on the general index, mainly caused by the decreases in the production of the *Manufacture of beverages* and the *Manufacture of dairy products*.

In turn, the **Energy** sector was the only one to have a positive influence on the general index, with an annual variation of **5.7%** and an effect of **0.796** due to the positive evolution of *Petroleum refinement* and of *Production, transport and distribution of electrical energy.*

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the annual rate of the IPI in the month of July.

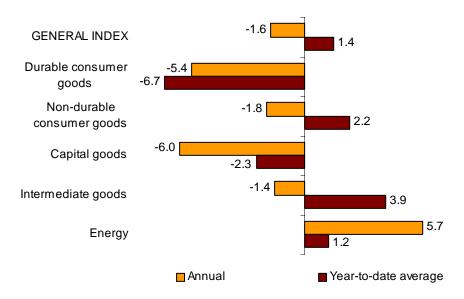

Year-to-date average rates

The average for the Industrial Production Index registered a variation rate of **1.4%** in the first seven months of the year, as compared with the same period the previous year.

By economic destination of the goods, this rate was positive for Intermediate goods (3.9%), Non-durable consumer goods (2.2%) and Energy (1.2%). Conversely, it was negative in Durable consumer goods (-6.7%) and in Capital goods (-2.3%).

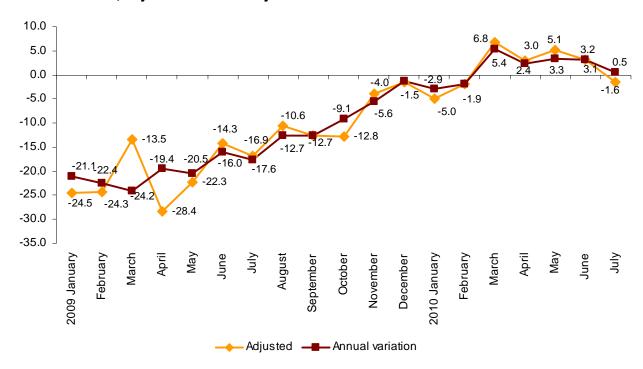
Annual and average rates of the IPI General index and by economic destination



Evolution of the IPI, adjusted for the calendar effect

After correcting the calendar effect, that is, the difference between the number of working days in a given month in different years, the interannual variation of the IPI in the month of July was **0.5%**, more than two-and-a-half points lower than that registered in June.

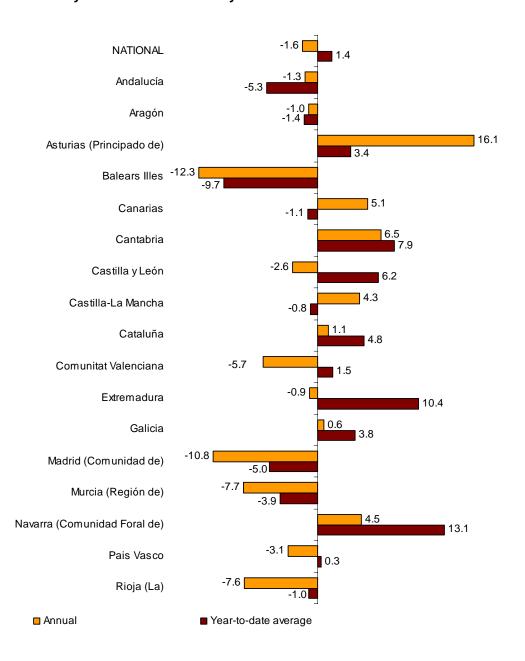
Annual evolution of the IPI General index, adjusted and non-adjusted



Results by Autonomous Community

A total of 10 Autonomous Communities registered negative interannual variations in July, among which, of note were Illes Balears (–12.3%) and Comunidad de Madrid (–10.8%). In turn, Principado de Asturias (16.1%) presented the highest positive annual rate.
