**Industrial Production Index. Base 2005
August 2009**

**The Industrial Production Index adjusted for calendar effects
decreases 13.1% in August as compared with the same month in 2008**

The General Industrial Production Index (IPI) experienced a -11.0% variation in August 2009 in comparison with the same month the previous year.

After adjusting for calendar effects, the interannual rate of the IPI registered a decrease of -13.1%.

By economic destination of the goods, the variation rates with respect to the same month the previous year were -6.6% for Consumer goods (-31.5% for Durable consumer goods and -3.9% for Non-durable consumer goods), -10.9% for Capital goods, 17.4% for Intermediate goods and -6.1% for Energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these interannual rates stood at -9.3% for Consumer goods (-35.1% for Durable consumer goods and -6.5% for Non-durable consumer goods), -13.0% for Capital goods, -19.6% for Intermediate goods and -6.9% for Energy.

**The average rate of the IPI adjusted for calendar effects decreases 19.7% in the
interannual rate in the first eight months of 2009**

The average IPI rate stood at -20.0% during the first eight months of 2009, in comparison with the same period of 2008. After adjusting for calendar effects, this average rate stood at -19.7%.

The evolution of the average industrial production rate by economic destination of the goods was -11.5% for Consumer goods (-32.6% for Durable consumer goods and -7.8% for Non-durable consumer goods), -27.0% for Capital goods, -26.6% for Intermediate goods and -8.7% for Energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these average rates for the first eight months stood at -11.0% for Consumer goods (-31.9% for Durable consumer goods and -7.4% for Non-durable consumer goods), -26.5% for Capital goods, -26.2% for Intermediate goods and -8.8% for Energy.

The activities which experienced the most moderate decreases during the January-August period of 2009 were *Manufacture of pharmaceutical products*, with -0.8%, and *Food industry*, with -1.7%.

In contrast, the activities which experienced the greatest decreases were *Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers*, with -39.8%, and *Manufacture of furniture*, with -34.4%.
