## Industrial Production Indices (IPI). Base 2010 August 2017. Provisional data


The monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index stands at 1.0%, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects

The annual rate of the Industrial Production Index stands at 1.8% in the series adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects and at 2.2% in the original series

#### Monthly evolution of industrial production

After adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, the monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index (IPI) between August and July stood at 1.0%. This rate was 1.3 points higher than that observed in July.


#### General Industrial Production Index Adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects. Monthly rate



By sector, *Capital goods* (3.2%) and Non-d*urable consumer goods* (0.8%) registered the highest positive monthly rates.

Conversely, *Energy* (-1.0%) is the only sector with a negative monthly rate.

A more detailed analysis showed the branches of activity with the greatest and lowest monthly rates in the month of August.



#### Annual evolution of industrial production

After adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, the Industrial Production Index registered a variation of 1.8% in August, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was 0.1 points lower than that observed in July.

The original series of the IPI registered an annual variation of 2.2%. This rate was 0.2 points higher than in the month of July.

### General Industrial Production Index Annual rate



In data adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, *Intermediate goods* (4.3%), *Durable consumer goods* (1.6%) and *Capital goods* (1.0%) registered the greatest increases as compared with the same month of 2016. No sector registered negative annual rates.



## Results by Autonomous Communities. Annual variation rates of industrial production. Original series

The annual rate of industrial production was positive in 11 Autonomous Communities. The greatest increases were recorded in Cantabria (11.1%), Aragón (10.0%) and Región de Murcia (8.8%).

Conversley, the Autonomous Communities with the greatest negative rates were Comunidad Foral de Navarra (–11.2%), Castilla y León (–11.1%) and Extremadura (–7.1%).
