## Industrial Production Indices (IPI). Base 2015 August 2022 Provisional data

After adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, the monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index stood at 0.4%


# The annual rate of the Industrial Production Index stands at 5.5% in the series adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects and at 5.8% in the original series


#### Monthly evolution of industrial production

After adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, the monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index (IPI) between August and July stood at 0.4%. This rate is 1.4 points higher than that observed in July.

Adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects. Monthly rate (percentage)






By sectors, *Capital goods* (5.3%) and *Non-durable consumer goods* (0.4%) showed positive monthly rates. On the other hand Durable consumer goods (-4.1%), *Energy* (-2.5%) and *Intermediate goods* (-1.5%) showed negative monthly rates.


#### Annual evolution of industrial production

The Industrial Production Index corrected for seasonal and calendar effects presents a variation of 5.5% in August with respect to the same month of the previous year. This rate is 0.1 points higher than that registered in July.

The original IPI series experienced an annual variation of 5.8%. This rate is 4.4 points higher than that of July.

Four of the five sectors showed positive annual rates. It is worth highlighting the increase in *Capital goods* (12.6%) followed by *Energy* (9.4%). The only sector that decreased was *Intermediate goods* (-3.2%).


# Results by Autonomous Communities. Annual variation rates of industrial production. Original series

The annual rate of industrial production increased as compared to August 2021 in 16 Autonomous Communities and fell in only one autonomous community.

The largest increases were recorded in Illes Balears (17.3%), Andalucia (13.7%) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (13.6%). The only increase was recorded in Cantabria (-4.9%).

#### **Data Review and Update**

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data of the IPI series corresponding to the last two months. In the case of the series adjusted for calendar effects and for seasonal and calendar effects, the series is revised from the beginning, following the INE standard. The results are available at INEBase.

#### Methodological note

The Industrial Production Index (IPI) is a short-term indicator that measures the monthly evolution of the productive activity of the industrial branches, excluding construction, contained in the National Classification of Economic Activities 2009 (CNAE-2009). It therefore investigates the activities included in sections B, C, D and division 36: Water collection, treatment and supply, from section E of the CNAE-2009.

The IPI measures the joint evolution of quantity and quality, eliminating the influence of prices.

Type of survey: monthly continuous survey.

**Base year:** 2015.

**Population scope**: industrial establishments whose main activity is included in sections B, C, D and division 36 of the CNAE-2009.

**Geographical scope**: the entire national territory.

**Sample size:** 11,500 industrial establishments and more than 1,100 products.

**Collection method:** completion of the questionnaire by the respondent using one of the following methods: internet (IRIA system), e-mail, fax, telephone or by postal mail.
