

Industrial Production Index (IPI). Base 2005

September 2010. Provisional data

Main results

- The Industrial Production Index experiences an interannual variation of -0.8% in September, more than four points below that registered in August.
- By economic destination of the goods, the sectors Durable consumer goods and Capital goods present negative interannual rates.
- The average rate of the IPI stands at 1.2% in the first three quarters of the year.
- Industrial production registers negative interannual rates in nine Autonomous
 Communities in the month of September.

Annual evolution of industrial production

The Industrial Production Index (IPI) experienced an interannual variation of **–0.8%** in September, more than four points below that registered in August.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that influenced the interannual decrease in industrial production in September were:

- Capital goods, with an annual variation of -6.0% and an effect of -1.256, fundamentally due to the evolution of the *Manufacture of metal elements for construction* and the *Manufacture of motor vehicles*.
- **Durable consumer goods**, with an annual rate of **-10.2%** and an effect of **-0.370** on the general index, caused by the decreases observed in all the activities in this sector.

Among the industrial sectors with a positive effect, the most important was:

• **Energy**, with an annual variation of **2.7%** and an effect of **0.374** on the general index, due to the positive evolution of *Production of precious metals and other non-ferrous metals* and *Petroleum refinement.*

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the annual rate of the IPI in the month of September.



Year-to-date average rates

The average for the Industrial Production Index registered a variation rate of **1.2%** in the first nine months of the year, as compared with the same period the previous year.

By economic destination of the goods, this rate was positive for Intermediate goods (3.6%), Non-durable consumer goods (2.2%) and Energy (1.7%). Conversely, it was negative in Durable consumer goods (–6.5%) and in Capital goods (–3.1%).


Annual and average rates of the IPI General index and by economic destination



Evolution of the IPI, adjusted for the calendar effect

After correcting the calendar effect, that is, the difference between the number of working days in a given month in different years, the interannual variation of the IPI in the month of September was **-1.4%**, three points lower than that registered in August.


Annual evolution of the IPI General index, adjusted and unadjusted



Results by Autonomous Community

A total of nine Autonomous Communities registered negative interannual variations in September, among which of note were Illes Balears (-14.2%) and Comunidad de Madrid (-9.9%). In turn, Principado de Asturias (6.7%) presented the highest positive annual rate.
