Industrial Production Index. Base 2000 November 2007

The Industrial Production Index adjusted for calendar effects decreases -0.6% in November as compared to the same month in 2006

The General Industrial Production Index (IPI) experienced a -0.6% decrease in November 2007 in comparison with the same month the previous year. After adjusting for calendar effects, the interannual variation of the IPI was estimated at -0.6%.

By economic destination of the goods, the variation rates with respect to the same month from the previous year were -2.4% for consumer goods (-5.2% for durable consumer goods and -1.9% for non-durable consumer goods), -0.2% for capital goods, -2.5% for intermediate goods and 8.6% for energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these interannual rates were estimated at -2.5% for consumer goods (-5.2% for durable consumer goods and -2.0% for non-durable consumer goods), -0.2% for capital goods, -2.5% for intermediate goods and 8.6% for energy.

The average rate of the IPI adjusted for calendar effects increases 2.3% in the first eleven months of 2007

The average IPI rate stood at 2.6% for the first eleven months of 2007 in comparison with the same period in 2006. After adjusting for calendar effects, this average rate stood at 2.3%.

The evolution of the average industrial production rate by economic destination of the goods was 2.2% for consumer goods (6.7% for durable consumer goods and 1.4% for non-durable consumer goods), 6.5% for capital goods, 1.7% for intermediate goods and 0.3% for energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these average rates for the first eleven months stood at 1.8% for consumer goods (6.2% for durable consumer goods and 1.0% for non-durable consumer goods), 6.3% for capital goods, 1.4% for intermediate goods and 0.2% for energy.

Activities with the greatest average growth in the January-November 2007 period were *Manufacture of machinery and equipment n.e.c.*, 10.8%, and *Manufacture of furniture; manufacturing n.e.c.*, 8.6%.

In contrast, those with the least growth were Manufacture of office machinery and computers, -12.4%, and Tanning and dressing of leather; manufacture of luggage, handbags, saddlery, harness and footwear, -8.2%.
