**Industrial Production Index. Base 2005
November 2009**

**The Industrial Production Index adjusted for calendar effects
decreases 5.7% in November as compared with the same month in
2008**

The General Industrial Production Index (IPI) experienced a -4.1% variation in November 2009 in comparison with the same month the previous year.

After adjusting for calendar effects, the interannual rate of the IPI also registered a decrease of 5.7%.

By economic destination of the goods, the variation rates with respect to the same month the previous year were 1.2% for Consumer goods (-13.1 for Durable consumer goods and 3.3% for Non-durable consumer goods), -9.0% for Capital goods, -3.3% for Intermediate goods and -9.9% for Energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these interannual rates stood at -0.9% for Consumer goods (-16.0% for Durable consumer goods and 1.3% for Non-durable consumer goods), -10.6% for Capital goods, -5.1% for Intermediate goods and -10.4% for Energy.

**The average rate of the IPI adjusted for calendar effects decreases 16.9% in the
interannual rate in the first eleven months of 2009**

The average IPI rate stood at -17.3% during the first eleven months of 2009, in comparison with the same period of 2008. After adjusting for calendar effects, this average rate stood at -16.9%.

The evolution of the average industrial production rate by economic destination of the goods was -9.6% for Consumer goods (-29.8% for Durable consumer goods and -6.1% for Non-durable consumer goods), -23.6% for Capital goods, -22.9% for Intermediate goods and -8.6% for Energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these average rates for the first eleven months stood at -9.0% for Consumer goods (-29.0% for Durable consumer goods and -5.6% for Non-durable consumer goods), -23.2% for Capital goods, -22.4% for Intermediate goods and -8.6% for Energy.

The only activity that experienced an increase during the January-November period were *Manufacture of basic pharmaceutical products* (0.4%). In contrast, the activities that experienced the most moderate decreases were *Food industry*, with -1.1%, and *Chemical industry*, with -4.0%

The activities that experienced the greatest decreases were *Manufacture of furniture* (-31.7%), and *Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers* (-30.9%).
