
Industrial Production Indices (IPI). Base 2010 November 2017. Provisional data

The monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index stands at 1.0%, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects

The annual rate of the Industrial Production Index stands at 4.2% in the series adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects and at 4.7% in the original series

Monthly evolution of industrial production


After adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, the monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index (IPI) between November and October stood at 1.0%. This rate is 0.4 points higher than that observed in October.



By sector, *Energy* (3.7%) and *Capital goods* (1.7%) presented the highest positive monthly rates.

In turn, *Durable consumer goods* (-0.7%), and *Non-durable consumer goods* (-0.4%) registered negative monthly rates.



Annual evolution of industrial production

After adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, the Industrial Production Index registered a variation of 4.2% in November, as compared with the same month of 2016. This rate is 0.2 points lower than that registered in October.

The original series of the IPI experienced an annual variation of 4.7%. This rate is 2.3 point lower than that of October.

General Industrial Production Index Annual rate



In data adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, *Intermediate goods* (6.4%), *Capital goods* (6.1%) and *Energy* (4.6%) registered the greatest increases as compared with November 2016.

In turn, Durable consumer goods (-0.3%) is the only sector with a negative annual rate.



Results by Autonomous Communities. Annual variation rates of industrial production. Original series

The annual rate of industrial production was positive in 13 Autonomous Communities. The greatest increases were recorded in Extremadura (23.2%), Región de Murcia (22.9%) and Principado de Asturias (13.8%).

Conversely, the Autonomous Communities showing the most negative annual rates were La Rioja (-4.8%), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (-4.2%) and Castilla y León (-2.7%).
