**Industrial Production Index. Base 2005
December 2009**

**The Industrial Production Index adjusted for calendar effects
decreases 1.4% in December as compared with the same month in
2008**

The General Industrial Production Index (IPI) experienced a -1.5% variation in December 2009 in comparison with the same month the previous year.

After adjusting for calendar effects, the interannual rate of the IPI also registered a decrease of 1.4%.

By economic destination of the goods, the variation rates with respect to the same month the previous year were 0.9% for Consumer goods (-6.3 for Durable consumer goods and 1.9% for Non-durable consumer goods), -8.4% for Capital goods, 4.8% for Intermediate goods and -8.1% for Energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these interannual rates stood at 1.0% for Consumer goods (-6.2% for Durable consumer goods and 2.0% for Non-durable consumer goods), -8.2% for Capital goods, 4.9% for Intermediate goods and -8.1% for Energy.

**The average rate of the IPI adjusted for calendar effects decreases 15.8% in the
interannual rate for the year 2009**

The average IPI rate stood at -16.2% for the year 2009, as compared with 2008. After adjusting for calendar effects, this average rate stood at -15.8%.

The evolution of the average industrial production rate by economic destination of the goods was -8.8% for Consumer goods (-28.3% for Durable consumer goods and -5.5% for Non-durable consumer goods), -22.5% for Capital goods, -21.4% for Intermediate goods and -8.6% for Energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these average rates for the year 2009 stood at -8.2% for Consumer goods (-27.7% for Durable consumer goods and -5.0% for Non-durable consumer goods), -22.1% for Capital goods, -21.0% for Intermediate goods and -8.6% for Energy.

The only activity that showed no decrease during 2009 was *Manufacture of basic pharmaceutical products* (0.0%). In contrast, the activities that experienced the most moderate decreases were *Food industry*, with -0.7%, and *Chemical industry*, with -1.9%

The activities that experienced the greatest decreases during the year 2009 were *Manufacture of furniture* (-30.4%), and *Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers* (-28.0%).
