# Industrial Production Index (IPI). Base 2005

December 2011. Provisional data

#### Main results

- The **interannual variation** of the **Industrial Production Index** for the month of **December** is **-6.9%**, one tenth above that registered in November.
- By economic destination of the goods, all sectors present negative interannual rates.
- Fourteen Autonomous Communities register negative interannual rates for the IPI in the month of December.
- Industrial production decreases 1.8% in the year 2011, as compared with 2010.

#### Annual evolution of industrial production

The Industrial Production Index (IPI) experienced an interannual variation of **–6.9%** in December, one tenth above that registered in November.

The industrial sectors that most influenced this interannual decrease in industrial production in the month of December were:

- Intermediate goods, with an annual variation of -8.3% and an effect of -2.611 on the general index, due to the decrease in production in the majority of activities comprising this sector. Nonetheless, worth noting the increase in *Manufacture of other chemical products* and the *Manufacture of basic chemical products, nitrogen compounds, fertilisers, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms*.
- Capital goods, with an annual rate of -9.5% and an effect of -1.820 on the general index, due to the negative evolution in the majority of activities comprising this sector. Worth noting among them were the decreases registered in the *Manufacture of metal elements for construction* and in the *Manufacture of components, pieces and accessories for motor vehicles*. In turn, among the activities with increases in production in this sector, highlighting *Manufacture of machinery for general purposes*.

- **Energy**, with an annual variation of **-6.4%** and an effect of **-1.084** mainly caused by the decrease in *Production, transport and distribution of electrical energy.*
- Non-durable consumer goods, with an annual variation of -2.6% and an effect of -0.762 on the general index, due to the decreases on production in the majority of activities comprising this sector. Worth noting among them were the *Manufacture of pharmaceutical specialities* and *Manufacture of other food products*. Conversely, among the increases, the most influential was the *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats*.

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the annual rate of the IPI in the month of December.



### Year-to-date average rates

The average for the Industrial Production Index registered a variation of **-1.8%** in 2011, as compared with the previous year.

By economic destination of the goods, in the year 2011, this rate was negative in Durable consumer goods (-10.8%), Energy (-3.6%), Intermediate goods (-2.6%) and Non-durable consumer goods (-0.3%). Conversely, it was positive in Capital goods (0.2%).


# Annual and average rates of the IPI General index and by economic destination



### Evolution of the IPI, adjusted for the calendar effect

After correcting the calendar effect, that is, the difference between the number of working days in a given month in different years, the interannual variation of the IPI in the month of December was **–3.7%**, more than three points higher than that registered in November.

# Annual evolution of the IPI General index, adjusted and unadjusted




### **Results by Autonomous Community**

Fourteen Autonomous Communities registered negative interannual variations in December. Those that presented the greatest interannual decreases in industrial production were Principado de Asturias (-14.7%), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (-13.9%) and Aragon (-13.8%). In turn, industrial production in Extremadura (27.9%), Región de Murcia (17.4%) and Andalucia (4.9%) registered the greatest increases interannual rates.

In whole of the year 2011, Canarias (-7.3%) and Galicia (-7.1%) presented the greatest decreses and Cantabria (4.6%) and Castilla y Leon (3.1%) registered the greatest increases.
