## Industrial Production Indices (IPI). Base 2015 December 2022 Provisional Data

The monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index stands at 0.8%, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects

The annual rate of the Industrial Production Index stands at 0.6% in the series adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects and at -3.4% in the original series


Throughout the year 2022, industrial production increased by 2.9% in the adjusted series and 2.4% in the original series

#### Monthly evolution of industrial production

After adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, the monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index (IPI) between December and November stood at 0.8%. This rate is 1.4 points higher than that observed in November.

Adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects. Monthly rate (percentage)






By sectors, *Durable consumer goods* (5.9%), *Energy* (3.9%) and *Capital goods* (2.8%) showed positive monthly rates. On the other hand, *Intermediate consumer goods* (-1.6%) and *Non-durable consumer goods* (-0.7%) showed negative monthly rates.

#### Annual evolution of industrial production

The Industrial Production Index, adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, recorded a variation rate of 0.6% in December, as compared to the same month of the previous year. This rate is 1.3 points higher than that registered in November.

The original IPI series experienced an annual variation of -3.4%. This rate is 1.9 points lower than that of November.

By sectors, *Durable consumer goods* (10.2%), *Intermediate goods* (5.3%) and *Non-durable consumer goods* (3.5%) showed positive annual rates. On the other hand, *Intermediate goods* (-5.0%) and *Energy* (-4.2%) showed negative annual rates.

**Throughout the year 2022** retail sales decreased by 2.9% in the series adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects and 2.4% in the original series.

# Results by Autonomous Communities. Annual variation rates of industrial production. Original series


The annual rate of industrial production increased as compared to December 2021 in four Autonomous Communities and decreased in the other 13.

The largest decreases were recorded in Región de Murcia (-20.9%), Principado de Asturias (-13.0%) and Castilla y León (-7.3%). The largest increases were recorded in Extremadura (20.3%), Canarias (3.8%) and Comunidad de Madrid (3.0%).

For the year 2022 as a whole, industrial production increased in thirteen Autonomous Communities and decreased in four. The greatest increases were registered in Illes Balears (138.4%) and Comunidad de Madrid (5.6%). And the greatest decreases were in Castilla y León (-3.0%) and Galicia (-1.5%).

#### **Data Review and Update**

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data of the IPI series corresponding to the last two months. In the case of the series adjusted for calendar effects and for seasonal and calendar effects, the series is revised from the beginning, following the INE standard. The results are available at INEBase.

#### Methodological note

The Industrial Production Index (IPI) is a short-term indicator that measures the monthly evolution of the productive activity of the industrial branches, excluding construction, contained in the National Classification of Economic Activities 2009 (CNAE-2009). It therefore investigates the activities included in sections B, C, D and division 36: Water collection, treatment and supply, from section E of the CNAE-2009.

The IPI measures the joint evolution of quantity and quality, eliminating the influence of prices.

**Type of survey:** monthly continuous survey.

Base year: 2015.

2015.

**Population scope**: industrial establishments whose main activity is included in sections B, C, D and division 36 of the CNAE-2009.

**Geographical scope**: the entire national territory.

**Sample size:** 11,500 industrial establishments and more than 1,100 products.

**Collection method:** completion of the questionnaire by the respondent using one of the following methods: internet (IRIA system), e-mail, fax, telephone or by postal mail.
