**The General Index of Industrial Prices increases 0.6% in January
with respect to the previous month**

The General Index of Industrial Prices recorded in January an increase of 0.6% with respect to the month of December in 2006. The activities that most influenced this variation are those of "Production and distribution of electricity and gas" (3.4%), "Manufacture of metallic products, except machinery and equipment" (2.1%) and "Manufacture of other non-metallic ore products" (1.9%). In contrast, amongst the activities registering a reduction with respect to the previous month, the one with greatest repercussion is "Coke and refinement of petroleum" (-4.0%).

Considering the classification by economic destination of the goods, the variation rates with respect to the previous month are 0.4% for consumer goods (1.0% for durable consumer goods and 0.3% for non-durable consumer goods), 1.0% for capital goods, 0.7% for intermediate goods and 0.3% for energy.

The General Index increases 2.7% in interannual rate

The General Index of Industrial prices increases 2.7% in January 2007 with respect to the same month from the previous year. The activities that most influence this variation are those of "Metallurgy" (12.6%) and "Production and distribution of electricity and gas" (5.0%).

By economic destination of the goods, the variation rates with respect to the same month from the previous year are 1.4% for consumer goods (3.0% for durable consumer goods and 1.1% for non-durable consumer goods), 2.9% for capital goods, 6.3% for intermediate goods and -1.1% for energy.
