**Industrial Price Indices. Base 2005**  
January 2009

**The General Industrial Price Index increases 0.4% in January as compared to the previous month**

In January, the General Industrial Price Index registered a 0.4% increase as compared with the month of December 2008. The activities that most influenced this variation were *Electricity and gas* (4.3%), *Manufacture of beverages* (2.4%) and *Manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery and equipment* (0.8%). In contrast, among the activities that recorded a decrease as compared with the previous month, the activities with the greatest repercussion were *Metallurgy* (-4.6%) and *Manufacture of food products* (-0.8%).

Considering classification by economic destination of the goods, the intermonthly variation rates were 0.3% for Consumer goods (0.6% for Durable consumer goods and 0.2% for Non-durable consumer goods), 0.5% for Capital goods, -1.1% for Intermediate goods and 3.0% for Energy.

**The interannual rate of industrial prices decreases 0.6%**

The General Industrial Price Index registered a decrease of 0.6% in January 2009, as compared with the same month the previous year. The activities that most influenced this variation were *Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products* (-33.7%), *Manufacture of food products* (-2.8%) and *Metallurgy* (-8.4%).

By economic destination of the goods, the interannual variation rates were 0.9% for Consumer goods (2.9% for Durable consumer goods and 0.5% for Non-durable consumer goods), 1.9% for Capital goods, -1.6% for Intermediate goods and -2.6% for Energy.

## Methodological Annex

### Change in the Industrial Price Indices to base 2005

Today, the National Statistics Institute (INE) is presenting the first Industrial Price Indices (IPRI) in base 2005, pursuant to the provisions of Regulation (EC) no. 1165/98 of the Council regarding short-term statistics.

This change of comparison base to the year 2005 indicates the **updating of the weightings, the basket of representative products and the panel of informant units** of the industrial price indices.

### Adaptation of the IPRI to CNAE-2009

In addition, beginning this month of January 2009, the Industrial Price Indices are adapted to the Classification of Economic Activities in force (CNAE-2009).

The Industrial Price Index, with base 2000, used the National Classification of Economic Activities from the year 1993 (CNAE-93). Royal Decree 475/2007, of 13 April 2007, passed National Classification of Economic Activities 2009 (CNAE-2009), to be applied as of January 2009.

For the purpose of **providing continuity to the data series**, the INE has linked all of the series from CNAE-2009 and the Large Industrial Sectors (LIS) with the indices calculated in this classification, from the information that the INE had already been publishing with base 2000. Some of these linked series begin in the year 1975. In turn, the series from the old National Classification of Economic Activities (CNAE-93) cease to be published.
