Industrial Price Index (IPRI). Base 2005

January 2012. Provisional data

Main results

- The **interannual** rate of the IPRI for the month of January is **3.6%**, more than one-and-half points below than the rate registered in December.
- The **monthly** variation of the general index is **0.8%**.
- All Autonomous Communities register positive interannual rates in January.
- The Autonomous Community that records the greatest interannual variation is **Canarias**, with **6.1%**.


Annual evolution of industrial prices

The interannual variation of the Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at 3.6% in January, more than one-and-half points below than the rate registered in December.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors with the most negative effect on the general index were:

- Energy, whose annual variation decreased almost five points, stood at 9.2%, the lower since September 2010. This drop was largely due to the increase in the price of the *Production, transport and distribution of electrical energy* is being lower than that experienced in January of the previous year. In fact, this activity stood at 2.8% their interannual rate, the lowest registered since September 2010.
- Intermediate goods, with an interannual rate of 1.7%, more than one point lower than that registered in December and the lower since March 2010. This drop was mainly due to the evolution in the prices of the *Manufacture of basic iron, steel and ferro-alloy products* and *Manufacture of animal feed products*, that increased less than in January 2011 and decreased, as compared with the same month of the previous year, respectively. Worth noting that the interannual rate *Manufacture of basic iron, steel and ferro-alloy products* (2.9%) is the lowest since March 2010 and *Manufacture of animal feed products* (-1.5%) stood at negative levels for first time since July 2010.

Annual rates of the IPRI General index and by economic destination




Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In January, the monthly variation of the IPRI was 0.8%.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sector with a positive monthly influence on the general index were, worth noting:

- **Energy**, with a monthly rate of **2.3**%, that reflected the increases in the prices of the *Petroleum refinement*. Its effect on the general index was **0.588**.
- Intermediate goods, whose monthly rate of **0.5%** contributed **0.160** to the general index. Worth noting in this variation the decrease in prices of the *Manufacture of basic chemical products, nitrogen compounds, fertilisers, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms* and the *Production of precious metals and other non-ferrous metals*.
- Capital goods, with an interannual variation of **0.4%**, that was largely due to the rise in the price of *Manufacture of motor vehicles*. This sector contributed **0.056** to the general index.

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of January.



Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

In all Autonomous Communities the annual rate decreased in January. The greatest decreases were in Illes Balears (5.1 points), Extremadura (2.9 points) and Canarias (2.7 points), whose rates stood at 2.2%, 1.3% and 6.1%, respectively.
