Industrial Price Indices. Base 2005
April 2009

The General Industrial Price Index decreases 0.3% in April as compared to the previous month

In April, the General Industrial Price Index registered a 0.3% decrease, as compared with the month of March 2009. The activities that registered a decrease on the previous month were *Production and distribution of electricity and gas* (–3.1%), *Manufacture of food products* (–0.6%) and *Manufacture of basic metals* (–1.5%). Conversely, among the activities that registered an increase with respect to the previous month, those with the greatest effect were *Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products* (7.0%).

Considering the classification by economic destination of the goods, the variation rates as compared with the previous month were -0.2% for Consumer goods (-0.1% for Durable consumer goods and -0.2% for Non-durable consumer goods), 0.1% for Capital goods, -0.5% for Intermediate goods and -0.4% for Energy.

The interannual rate of industrial prices decreases 3.4%

The General Industrial Price Index registered a 3.4% decrease in April 2009, as compared with the same month the previous year. The activities that most influenced this variation were *Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products* (–37.9%), *Manufacture of basic metals* (–21.1%) and *Manufacture of food products* (–5.7%).

By economic destination of the goods, the interannual variation rates were -0.8% for Consumer goods (1.4% for Durable consumer goods and –1.2% for Non-durable consumer goods), 1.2% for Capital goods, –5.5% for Intermediate goods and –6.7% for Energy.
