

Industrial Price Index (IPRI). Base 2005
May 2010. *Provisional data*

Main Results

- The **interannual** variation rate of the **IPRI** in **May** increases one tenth, standing at **3.8%**.
- The **monthly** variation of the general index is **0.2%**.
- Only two **Autonomous Communities** register negative **interannual** rates in May, with **Comunidad de Madrid** being of note (**-1.5%**).
- In turn, **Andalucía** experiences the highest interannual variation rate, with **9.6%**.

Annual evolution of industrial prices

The interannual rate of the Industrial Price Index (IPRI) in May was 3.8%, one tenth more than that registered in April.

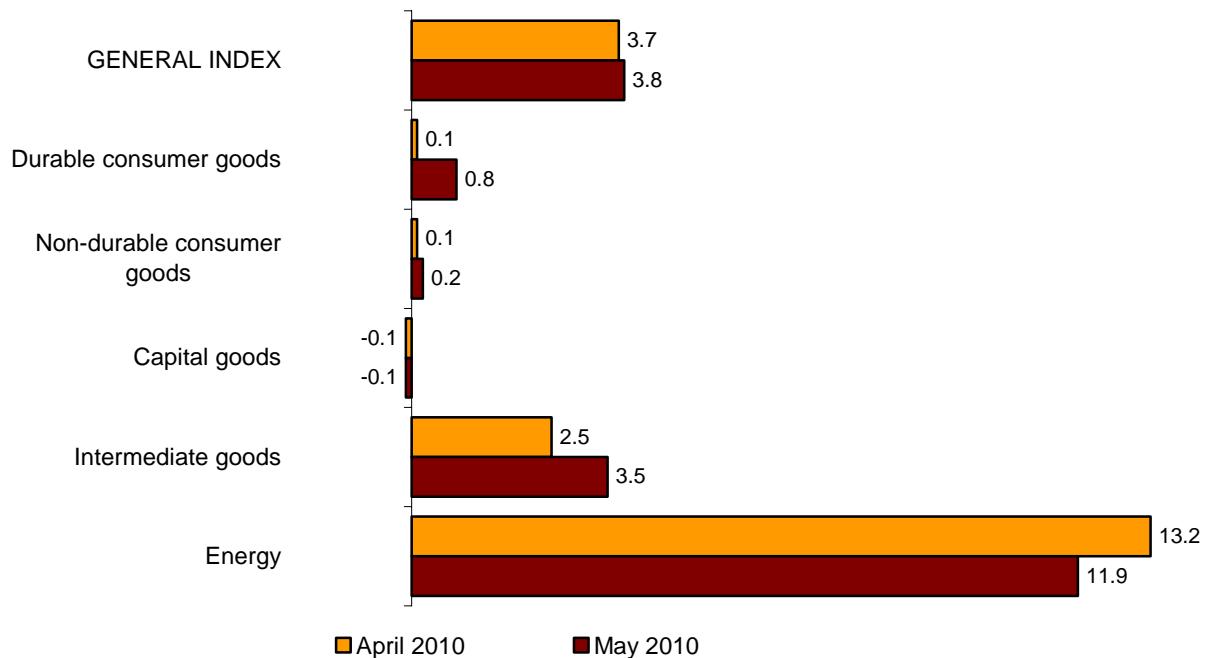
By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that most influenced this increase in the annual rate were:

- **Intermediate Goods**, whose annual rate stood at **3.5%**, one point more than that registered in April. Worth noting in this increase were the increases registered in *Manufacture of basic products in iron, steel and ferro-alloys* and in *Production of precious metals and other non-ferrous metals*, which fell in May 2009.

Despite the increase in the annual rate, it is worth noting the negative influence of the following industrial sector:

- **Energy**, whose annual variation decreased more than one point, standing at **11.9%**, largely due to the prices of *Petroleum refinement* increasing this month to a lesser extent than in May last year, and of *Production, transport and distribution of electrical energy* decreasing in May 2010 with greater intensity than in 2009.

Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In May, the monthly variation of the IPRI was **0.2%**.

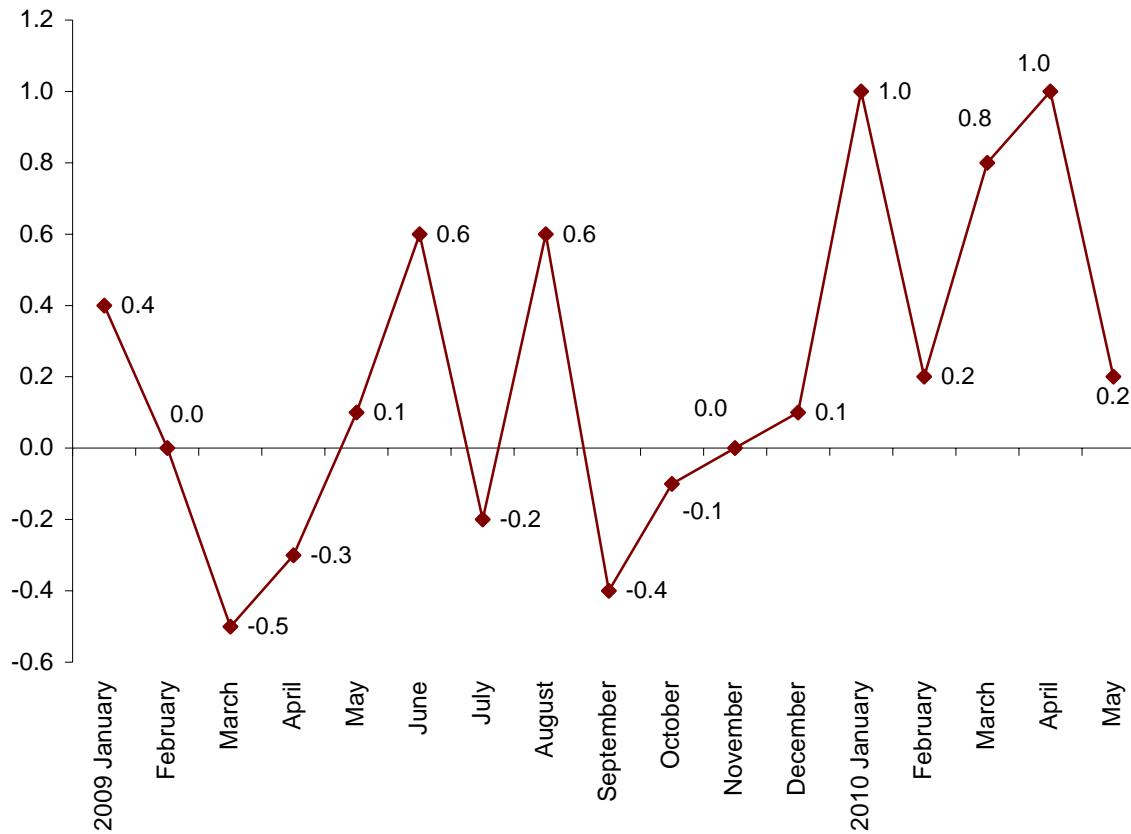
By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sector with the greatest positive monthly effect on the general index was:

- **Intermediate goods**, whose monthly rate stood at **0.7%**. Of note in this variation are the price increases of *Manufacture of basic products in iron, steel and ferro-alloys*, *Manufacture of basic chemical products, nitrogen compounds, fertilisers, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms* and *Production of precious metals and other non-ferrous metals*. Their contribution to the general index was **0.230**.

Likewise, the only sector with a negative monthly effect on the general index was:

- **Non-durable consumer goods**, with a monthly rate of **-0.2%**, and an effect of **-0.043**, which included, among others, the drop in prices of *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products* and *Manufacture of beverages*.

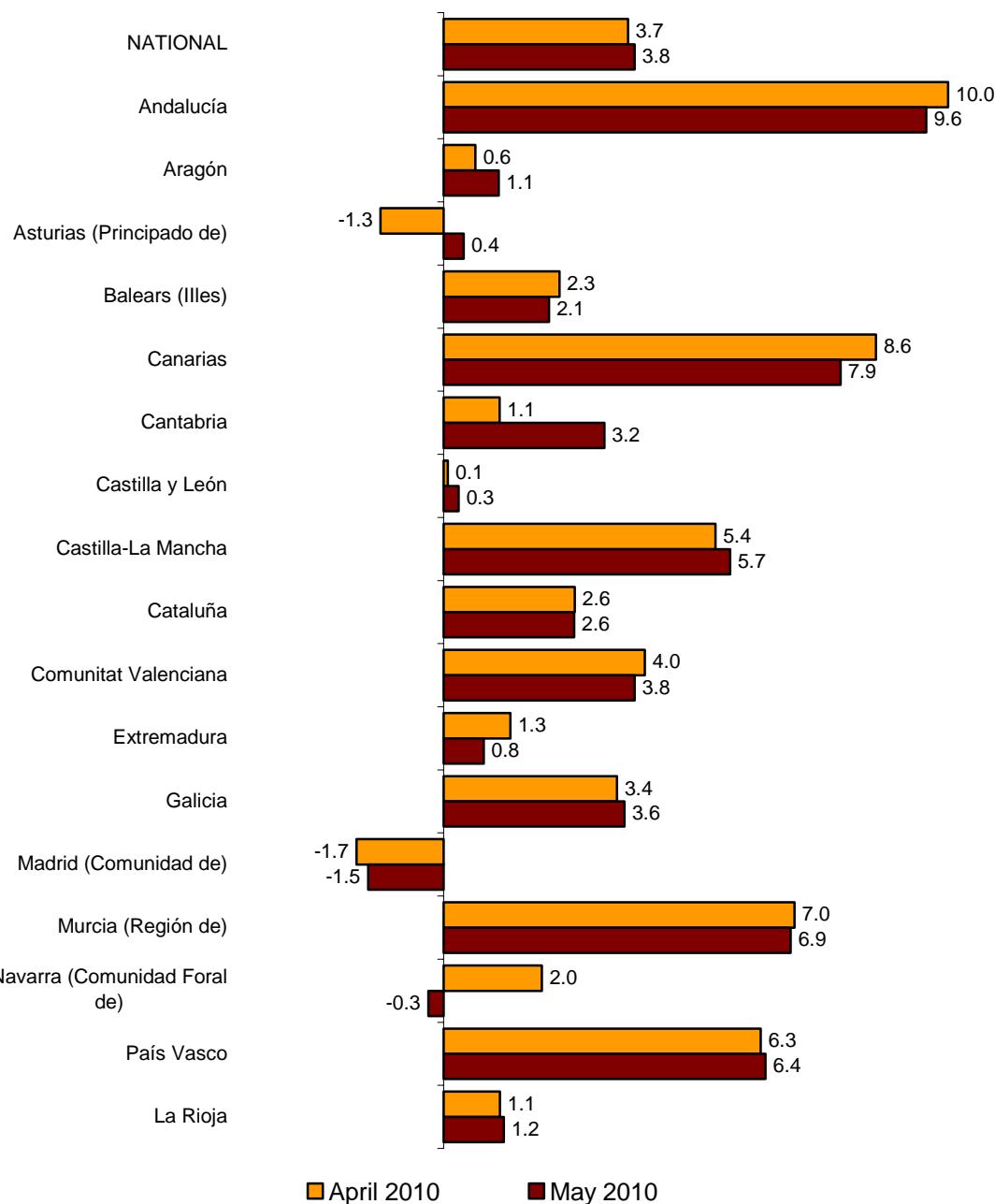

Results by Autonomous Community. Interannual variation rates

The greatest increases in annual variation corresponded to the Autonomous Communities of Cantabria (2.1 points) and Principado de Asturias (1.7 points), whose rates stood at 3.2% and 0.4%, respectively.

In turn, the Autonomous Community that decreased its annual rate the most was Comunidad Foral de Navarra, from 2.0% registered in April to -0.3% in May.
