

Industrial Price Index (IPRI). Base 2005
June 2010. *Provisional data*

Main Results

- The **interannual** variation rate of the IPRI for the month of June increases six tenths and stands at **3.2%**.
- The **monthly** variation of the overall index is **0.1%**.
- All **Autonomous Communities** registered positive **interannual** rates in June except **Comunidad de Madrid** (**-1.6%**).
- Conversely, **Andalucía** experienced the highest interannual variation rate with **7%**.

Annual evolution of industrial prices

The interannual rate for the Industrial Price Index (IPRI) in June was 3.2%, six tenths less than that registered in May.


By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sector that most influenced this decrease in the annual rate was:

- **Energy**, whose annual rate stood at **8.5%**, three-and-a-half points below that registered in May. This decrease is due, primarily, to the decrease in prices of *Refined petroleum products* this month, as compared with the increase experienced in June 2009.

However, it is also worth noting the positive influence by the following industrial sector:

- **Intermediate Goods**, whose annual rate increased three tenths, standing at **3.8%**, largely due to the prices of *Manufacture of basic products in iron, steel and ferro-alloys* rising this month, whereas they fell in June last year.

Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In June, the monthly variation of the IPRI was **0.1%**.


By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that presented a greater positive effect on the General index were:

- **Non-durable consumer goods**, whose monthly rate stood at **0.2%**. This rate was largely due to the rise in prices of *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products* and of *Manufacture of tobacco*. Their contribution to the overall index was **0.043**.
- **Intermediate goods**, which contributed **0.029** to the overall index, with a monthly rate of **0.1%**. Of note in this variation are the price increases of *Manufacture of pulp, paper and cardboard* and of the *Manufacture of basic products in iron, steel and ferro-alloys*.

Likewise, the only sector with a negative monthly effect in the general index was:

- **Energy**, with a monthly rate of **-0.1%**, and an effect of **-0.018**, due to the drop in prices of *Petroleum refinement*.



Results by Autonomous Community. Interannual variation rates

The greatest decreases in the annual variation corresponded to the Autonomous Communities of Andalucía (2.6 points), Canarias (2.4 points) and Región de Murcia (2.0 points), whose rates stood at 7.0%, 5.9% and 4.9%, respectively.

In turn, the Autonomous Community increased its annual rate the most was Principado de Asturias, from 0.3% registered in May to 1.4% in June.
