## Industrial Price Index (IPRI). Base 2005 June 2012. Provisional data

#### Main results

- The **interannual** rate of the IPRI for the month of June is **2.5%**, seven tenths below the rate registered in May.
- The **monthly** variation of the general index is **-0.5**%.
- The most **Autonomous Communities** register **positive interannual** rates in June.
- The Autonomous Community that records the greatest interannual variation is **Illes Balears**, with **5.4%**.

#### Annual evolution of industrial prices

The interannual variation of the Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at 2.5% in June, seven tenths above the rate registered in May.


By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors with the highest negative effect on the general index were:

- **Energy**, whose interannual variation decreased more than two points, standing at **6.9%**, the lowest rate since February 2010. This drop was due to the decrease in prices of *Petroleum refinement*, that registered the lowest annual rate since November 2009.
- Intermediate goods, whose annual rate was 0.7%, three tenths below than that registered in May and the lowest since March 2010. This decrease was due to the drop in prices of Manufacture of basic iron, steel and ferro-alloy products.

On the other hand, the only industrial sector with a positive effect on the general index was:

• Capital goods, whose annual variation stood at 0.9%, one tenth higher than that registered the previous month. The activity that highlighting by its influence in this rise was *Manufacture of motor vehicles*, due to that the increase in prices this month was higher than that registered the same month the previous year.

# Annual rates of the IPRI General index and by economic destination




#### Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In June, the monthly variation of the IPRI was -0.5%.

By economic destination of the goods, the sectors that presented the greatest negative monthly effect on the general index were:

- **Energy**, with a monthly variation of **-1.8%**, that reflected the decrease in prices of *Petroleum refinement*. Its effect on the general index was **-0.493**.
- Intermediate goods, with a monthly variation of –0.3% contributed –0.104. This was due, mainly, to the decrease in prices of *Manufacture of basic chemical products, nitrogen compounds, fertilisers, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms* and *Manufacture of basic iron, steel and ferro-alloy products.*

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of June.



#### Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

In almost all Autonomous Communities the annual rate decreased in June. The greatest decreases corresponded to Castilla-La Mancha (1.7 points), Region de Murcia (1.6 points) and Andalucia (1.5 points), whose rates stood at 3.1%, 3.0% and 2.1%, respectively.

In turn, worth noting the increase of the annual rate in La Rioja (1.7 points), standing at 3.5%.
