



Industrial Price Indices. Base 2000 July 2008

The General Industrial Price Index increases 1.4% in July as compared with the previous month

In July, the General Industrial Price Index registered a 1.4% increase with respect to the month of June 2008. The activities that most influenced this variation were *Electricity and gas* (7.2%), *Manufacture of coke oven products and refinement of petroleum* (2.4%), *Metallurgy* (3.5%) and *Chemical industry* (1.3%). In contrast, among the activities that recorded a decrease as compared with the previous month, the activity with the greatest repercussion was the *Manufacture of electrical machinery and material* (-0.2%).

Considering the classification by economic destination of the goods, the variation rates as compared with the previous month were 0.1% for consumer goods (0.1% for durable consumer goods and 0.1% for non-durable consumer goods), 0.3% for capital goods, 1.1% for intermediate goods and 4.7% for energy.

The interannual rate of the General Index increases 10.2%

The General Industrial Price Index registered an increase of 10.2% in July 2008 with respect to the same month from the previous year. The activities that most influenced this variation were *Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products* (52.1%) and *Food and beverage products industry* (10.0%).

By economic destination of the goods, the interannual variation rates as compared with the previous year were 5.2% for consumer goods (3.3% for durable consumer goods and 5.6% for non-durable consumer goods), 2.3% for capital goods, 7.3% for intermediate goods and 30.3% for energy.
