Industrial Price Index. Base 2010 July 2017 Provisional data

The annual variation of the Industrial Price Index stands at 3.2%, the same than that registered in the month of June

The monthly variation of industrial prices is 0.0%

Annual evolution of industrial prices

The annual rate for the general Industrial Price Index (IPRI) in July is **3.2%**, the same than that registered in June.

By economic destination of the goods, the only industrial sector with a positive contribution was:

• *Energy*, whose annual variation stood at **6.5%**, seven tenths above that of the previous month, due to the stability in the prices of *Manufacture of refined petroleum products*, as compared with the decrease registered in July 2016.

It is noteworthy, although in the opposite direction, the decrease in the prices of *Electric power generation, transmission and distribution*, which increased in the previous year.


On the other hand, among the sectors with a negative contribution in the maintenance of the IPRI annual rate, worth noting were:

• Intermediate goods, whose variation rate decreased by two tenths, to 2.6%. This behaviour was due to the stability in the prices of Manufacture of basic chemical products, nitrogen compounds, fertilisers, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms, which increased in July last year.

Another reason for this variation –though to a lesser extent– was that the prices for the *Production of precious metals and other non-ferrous metals*, increased this month less than they did in 2016.


- **Non-durable consumer goods**, with a variation rate of **2.1%**, that is, two tenths lower than that of June, due to the stability in the prices of *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products*, as compared with the increase registered last year, and to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats*, which increased in 2016.
- *Capital goods*, that registered a variation rate of **0.8%**, two tenths lower than that of the previous month. This was mainly due to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of metal elements for construction*, which increased in July 2016.

The annual variation rate of the **general index excluding** *Energy* decreased two tenths, up to **2.0%** standing more than one point below that of the general IPRI.

Monthly evolution of industrial prices

The monthly variation of the overall IPRI was **0.0%** in July.

By economic destination of the goods, among the industrial sectors that presented the greatest positive contribution, worth noting were:

• *Intermediate goods*, that presented a variation rate of **0.1%** and a contribution of **0.041**. Of particular note in this behaviour is the increase in the prices of *Production of precious metals* and other non-ferrous metals.


It is also noteworthy, although in the opposite direction, the decrease in the prices of the *Manufacture of basic chemical products, nitrogenous compounds, fertilisers, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms.*

In turn, among the sectors that presented a negative effect on the general index, the most relevant were:

• *Energy*, whose variation rate stood at -0.1%, mainly due to the decrease in the prices of *Electric power generation, transmission and distribution*. Its contribution to the general IPRI was -0.018.

It is also noteworthy, although in a positive sense, the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of gas; distribution of gaseous fuels through mains*.

• *Capital goods*, whose monthly rate stood at **-0.1%**, with a contribution of **-0.015**, mainly due to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of metal elements for construction*.



A more detailed analysis shows the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of July.


Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

The annual rate of the IPRI increased in nine Autonomous Communities and decreased in the remaining eight. The greatest increases were recorded in País Vasco, Andalucía and Canarias, whose annual rates increased 1.1, 0.9 and 0.6 points respectively.

In turn, Principado de Asturias, Illes Balears and Cantabria were the Autonomous Communities with the highest decreases in annual rate, with decreases of 2.7, 1.2 and 0.8 points respectively.
