#### Industrial Price Index (IPRI). Base 2005 August 2012. Provisional data

The annual rate of the Industrial Price stands at 4.1%, oneand-a-half points above the rate registered in July 2012

The inter-monthly variation of the IPRI is 1.1% in August

#### Annual evolution of industrial prices

The interannual variation of the Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at 4.1% in July, one-and-a-half tenth above the rate registered in July.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors with positive effect on the general index were:

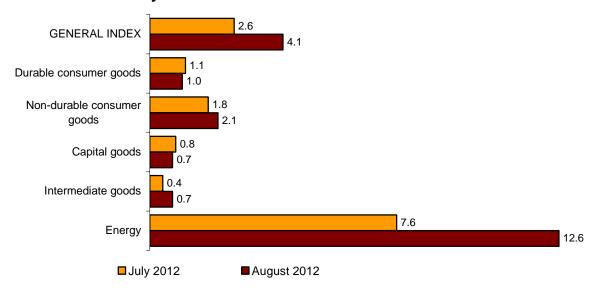
• **Energy**, whose interannual variation increased five points, standing at **12.6%**. This rise was due to the increase in prices of the *Petroleum refinement* and *Production, transport and distribution of electrical energy*, as compared with the decrease registered in August 2011.

Worth noting the rise of twelve points in the annual rate of the *Petroleum refinement*, standing at 16.9%.

- Intermediate goods, whose annual rate stood at 0.7%, three tenths above than that registered in July. Among the activities that influenced in this rise, highlighted the *Manufacture of animal feed products*, whose prices increased in August, while decreased in the same month of the previous year.
- Non-durable consumer goods, that increased its annual rate three tenths and stood at 2.1%. In this variation, highlighted the increase in prices of *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats* and *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products*.

Also, worth noting that the annual rate of *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats* stood at 8.6%, the highest since August 2008.

# Annual rates of the IPRI General index and by economic destination



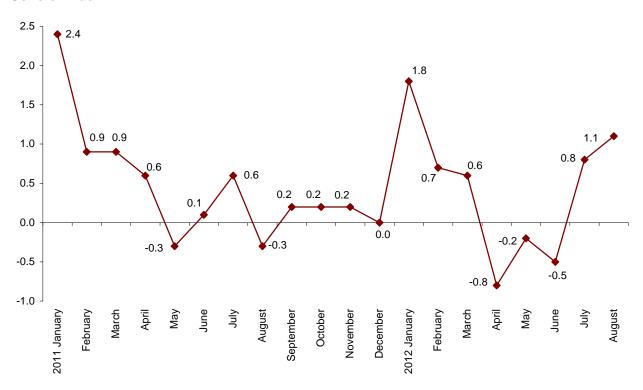
#### Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In August, the monthly variation of the IPRI was 1.1%.

By economic destination of the goods, the sectors that presented the greatest positive monthly effect on the general index were:

- Energy, with a monthly variation of 3.1%, that reflected the increase in prices of the *Petroleum refinement* and lesser extend *Production, transport and distribution of electrical energy.* Its effect on the general index was **0.835**.
- Non-durable consumer goods, whose monthly variation of 0.5% contributed 0.116. In these variation highlighting the increase in prices of the *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats* and *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products*.
- Intermediate goods, with a monthly variation of **0.3%** contributed **0.104**. This was due, mainly, to the increase in prices of the *Manufacture of animal feed products*.

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of August.

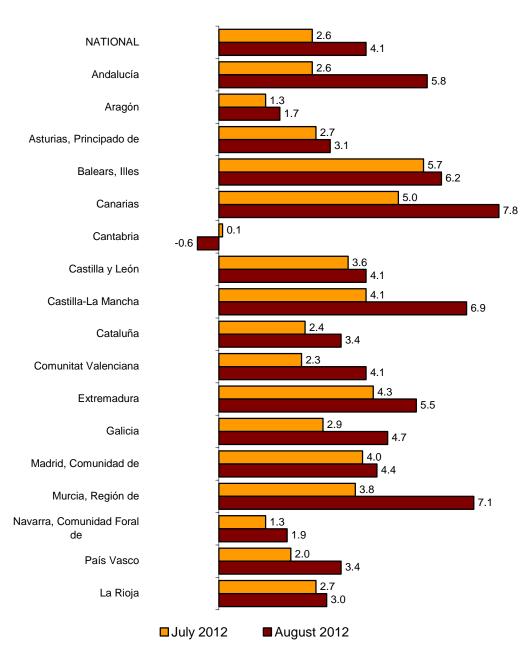

#### Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

In all Autonomous Communities the annual rate increased in August, except in Cantabria. In this Autonomous Communities decreased seven tenths and stood at –0.6%.

The greatest increases corresponded to Region de Murcia (3.3 points), Andalucia (3.2 points) and Castilla-La Mancha and Canarias (2.8 points each), standing their annual rates at 7.1%, 5.8%, 6.9% and 7.8%, respectively.
