**Industrial Price Indices. Base 2000**  
September 2008

**The General Industrial Price Index decreases 0.7% in September as compared with the previous month**

In September, the General Industrial Price Index registered a 0.7% decrease as compared with the month of August 2008. The activities that most influenced this variation were *Manufacture of coke oven products and refinement of petroleum* (-5.0%) and Metallurgy (-1.7%). In contrast, among the activities that recorded an increase as compared with the previous month, the activity with the greatest repercussion was *Chemical industry* (0.7%)

Considering the classification by economic destination of the goods, the intermonthly variation rates as compared with the previous month were -0.2% for consumer goods (0.2% for durable consumer goods and -0.2% for non-durable consumer goods), -0.1% for intermediate goods and -2.6% for energy. Capital goods did not experience any variation.

**The interannual rate of the General Index increases 8.1%**

The General Industrial Price Index registered an increase of 8.1% in September 2008, as compared with the same month from the previous year. The activities that most influenced this variation were *Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products* (32.0%) and *Production and distribution of electricity and gas* (13.8%).

By economic destination of the goods, the interannual variation rates as compared with the previous year were 4.2% for consumer goods (3.4% for durable consumer goods and 4.3% for non-durable consumer goods), 2.1% for capital goods, 7.1% for intermediate goods and 21.6% for energy.
