Industrial Price Indices. Base 2005
September 2009

The Industrial Price Index decreases 0.4% in September, as compared to the previous month

The interannual rate reaches –5.4%, one point less than in August 2009

Monthly variation rates

In September, the Industrial Price Index registered a 0.4% decrease, as compared to the month of August 2009. Of the activities that registered a decrease in the previous month, those with the greatest effect were *Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products* (-5.7%) and *Electricity, gas and water supply* (-0.6%).

Conversely, among the activities that registered an increase with respect to the previous month, that with the greatest effect was *Manufacture of basic metals* (0.8%).

Considering the classification by **economic destination of the goods**, the variation rates as compared with the previous month were 0.1% for *Consumer goods* (-0.2% for *Durable consumer goods* and 0.1% for *Non-durable consumer goods*), 0.1% for *Capital goods*, 0.1% for *Intermediate goods* and -2.2% for *Energy*.

Interannual variation rates

The Industrial Price Index registered a 5.4% decrease in September 2009, as compared with the same month the previous year. The activities that most influenced this variation were *Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products* (-34.3%), *Manufacture of basic metals* (-25.5%) and *Manufacture of food products* (-4.4%).

By **economic destination of the goods**, the interannual variation rates were -0.7% for *Consumer goods* (0.5% for *Durable consumer goods* and -0.8% for *Non-durable consumer goods*), 0.3% for *Capital goods*, -7.4% for *Intermediate goods* and -11.5% for *Energy*.
