**Industrial Price Index (IPRI). Base 2005**  
September 2010. *Provisional data*

### Main Results

- The **interannual** variation rate of the IPRI for the month of September stands at **3.4%**, seven tenths more than that registered in August.
- The **monthly** variation of the general index is **0.2%**.
- All **Autonomous Communities** register positive **interannual** rates.
- **País Vasco** is the Autonomous Community that presents the highest interannual variation rate, with **6.4%**.


### Annual evolution of industrial prices

The interannual rate for the Industrial Price Index (IPRI) increased seven tenths in September, standing at **3.4%**.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that most influenced this increase were:

- **Energy**, whose annual variation stood at **9.1%**, more than two points higher than that registered in August. This increase is due to the increase in prices of *Refined petroleum products*, as compared with the decrease experienced in September the previous year. In fact, the annual rate of this activity increased eight points, standing at 24.4%.
- **Intermediate Goods**, whose interannual variation increased six tenths, standing at **4.0%**, primarily due to the rise in prices of *Manufacture of animal feed products*, which decreased in September last year.

### Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In September, the monthly variation of the IPRI was **0.2%**.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that presented the greatest positive effect on the general index were:


- **Intermediate goods**, which contributed **0.172** to the general index, with a monthly rate of **0.5%**. Of note in this variation were the price increases of the *Manufacture of animal feed products* and the *Manufacture of basic products in iron, steel and ferro-alloys*.

**Non-durable consumer goods**, with a monthly rate of **0.3%**, due to the increase in prices of most of their components, worth noting among them *Processing and preserving of meat and preparation of meat products*. It had an effect of **0.064** on the general index.

Likewise, the only sector with a negative monthly influence on the general index was:

- **Energy**, with a monthly rate of **-0.3%** and an effect of **-0.072** on the general index. This behaviour reflected the drop in prices of the *Production, transport and distribution of electrical energy*.



## Results by Autonomous Community. Interannual variation rates

The greatest increases in annual variation corresponded to the Autonomous Communities of Región de Murcia (1.6 points), Comunitat Valenciana (1.4 points) and Andalucía (1.3 points), whose rates stood at 6.1%, 4.1% and 5.8%, respectively.

In turn, the only Autonomous Community whose annual rate decreased was Illes Balears, from 1.1% registered in August to 0.9% in September.
