**The annual rate of the Industrial Price decreases three tenths  
in September and stands at 3.8%**

**Annual evolution of industrial prices**

The interannual variation of the Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at 3.8% in September, three tenths below the rate registered in August.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sector that most influenced in this drop was:

- **Energy**, whose annual variation decreased almost three points, standing at **9.8%**. This drop was due to that the decrease in prices of the *Production, transport and distribution of electrical energy* was higher than in September 2011 and due to that the increase in prices of *Petroleum refinement* was lower than in the same month previous year.

Among the industrial sectors with the most positive effect on the annual rate, worth noting the following:

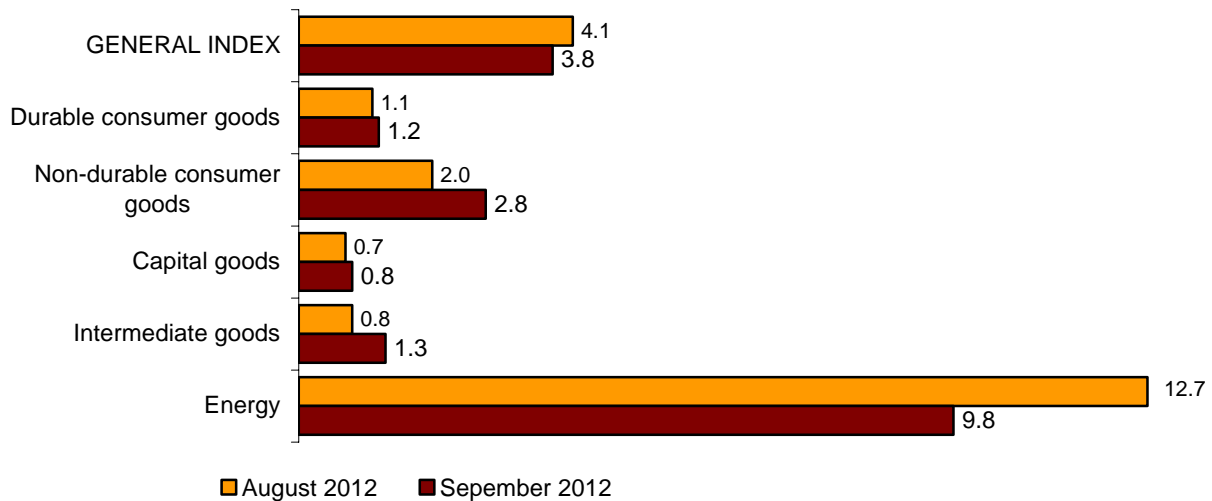
- **Non-durable consumer goods**, that increased its annual rate eight tenths, up to **2.8%**. This rise was due to the increase in prices of *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats*, as compared with the decrease in September 2011, and that the prices of *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products* increased more this month than in the same month previous year.

Worth noting that the annual rate of the *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats* stood at 18.1%, the highest since May 2006.

- **Intermediate goods**, whose annual variation was **1.3%**, five tenths above than that registered in August. Among the activities that influenced in this rise, highlighted the *Manufacture of basic chemical products, nitrogen compounds, fertilisers, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms* and the *Manufacture of animal feed products*, whose prices increased in September, while decreased in the same month in 2011.

## Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In September, the monthly variation of the IPRI was **-0.1%**.

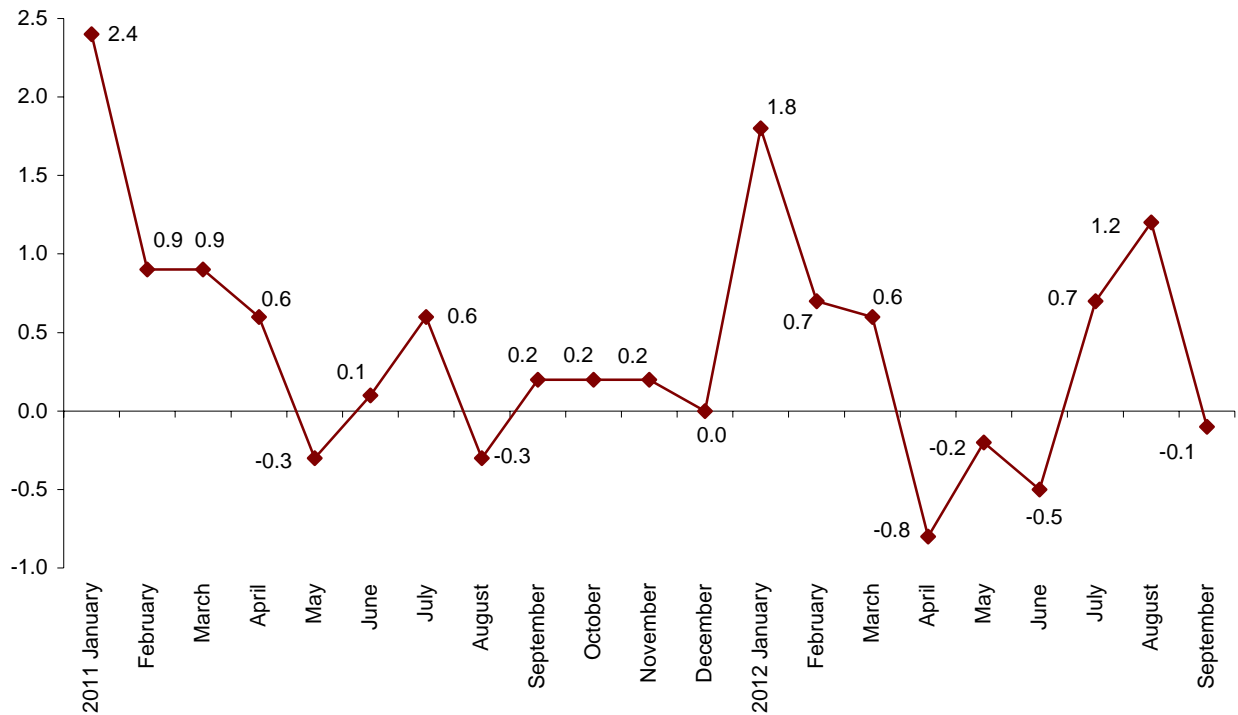
By economic destination of the goods, the sectors that presented the greatest negative effect on the general index were:

- **Energy**, with a monthly variation of **-1.5%**, that reflected the decrease in prices of the *Production, transport and distribution of electrical energy*. Its effect on the general IPRI was **-0.405**.

In turn, the sectors that presented the greatest positive effect on the general index were:

- **Non-durable consumer goods**, whose monthly variation of **0.8%** contributed **0.172**. In this variation highlighting the increase in prices of the *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats* and *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products*.
- **Intermediate goods**, with a monthly variation of **0.3%** contributed **0.103**, mainly, due to the increase in prices of the *Manufacture of basic chemical products, nitrogen compounds, fertilisers, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms* and the *Manufacture of animal feed products*.

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of September.

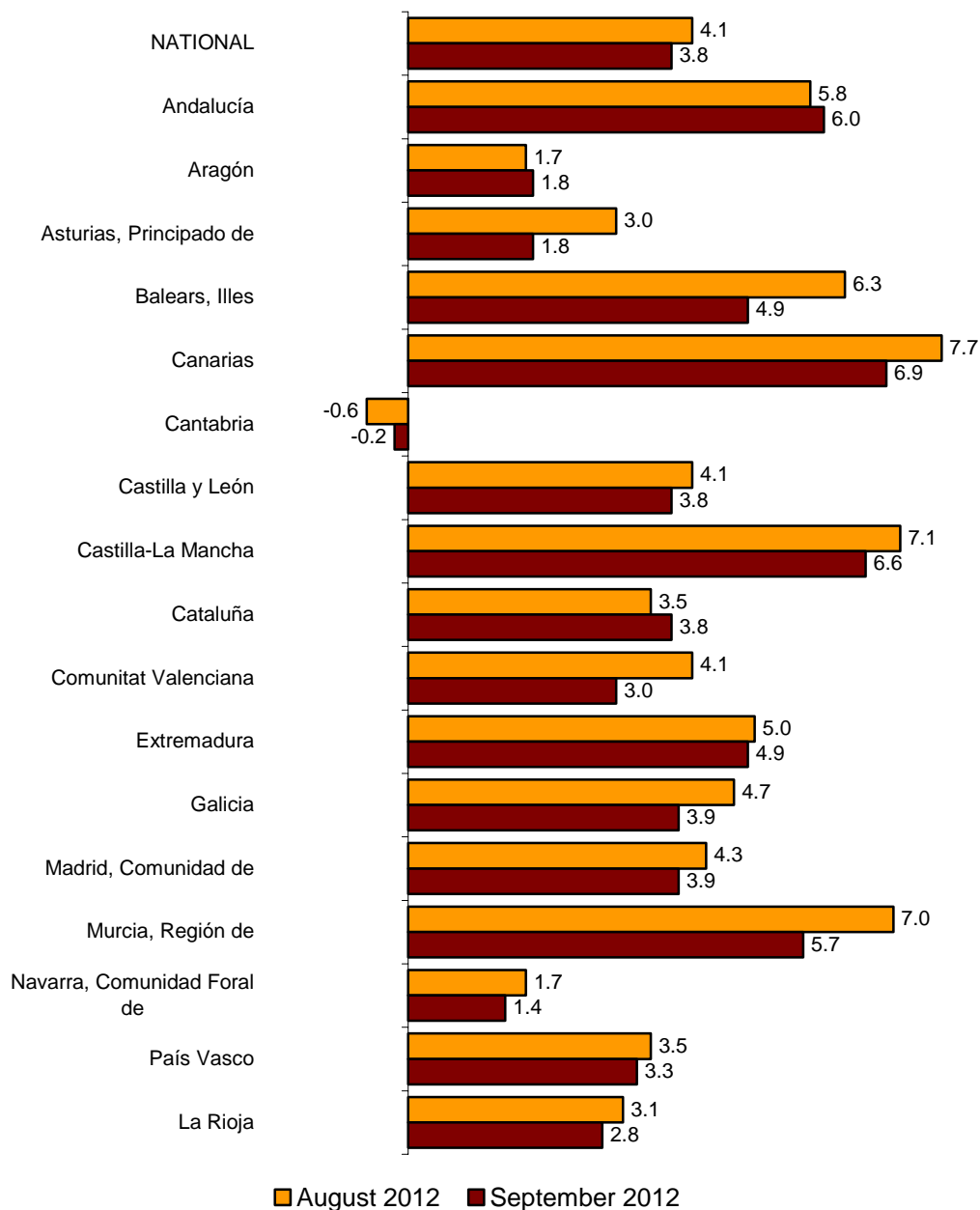
## Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

The annual rate of the IPRI decreased in September in the most of Autonomous Communities.

The greatest decreases corresponded to Illes Balears (1.4 points), Region de Murcia (1.3 points) and Principado de Asturias (1.2 points), stood their annual rates at 4.9%, 5.7% and 1.8%, respectively.
