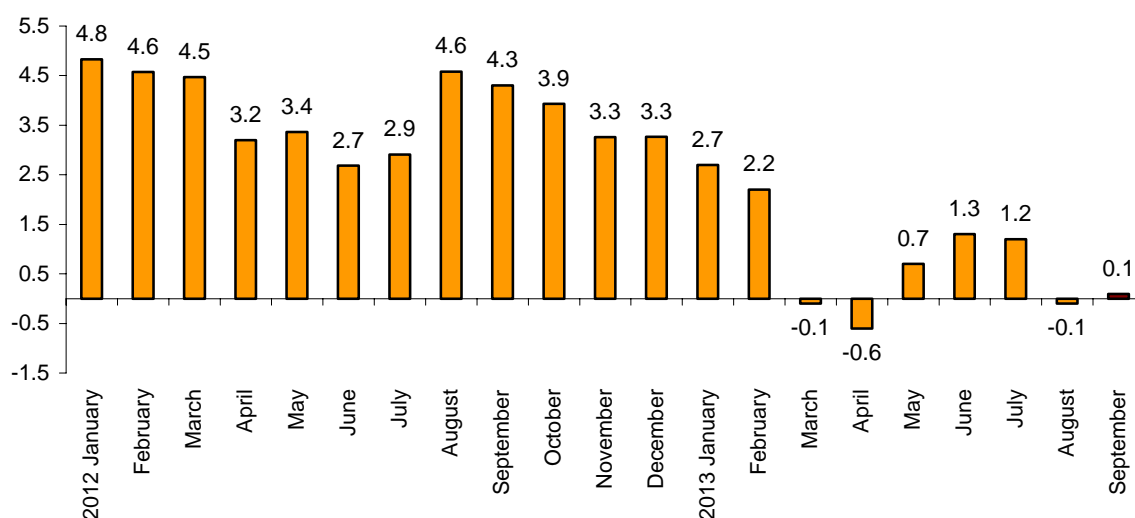
**The annual rate of the Industrial Price Index stands at 0.1%,  
two tenths over that registered in August**

**Annual evolution of industrial prices**

The annual rate of the Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at **0.1%** in September, two tenths over that registered in August.

By economic destination of the goods, the only industrial sector that most influenced the increase in the general rate of the IPRI was:

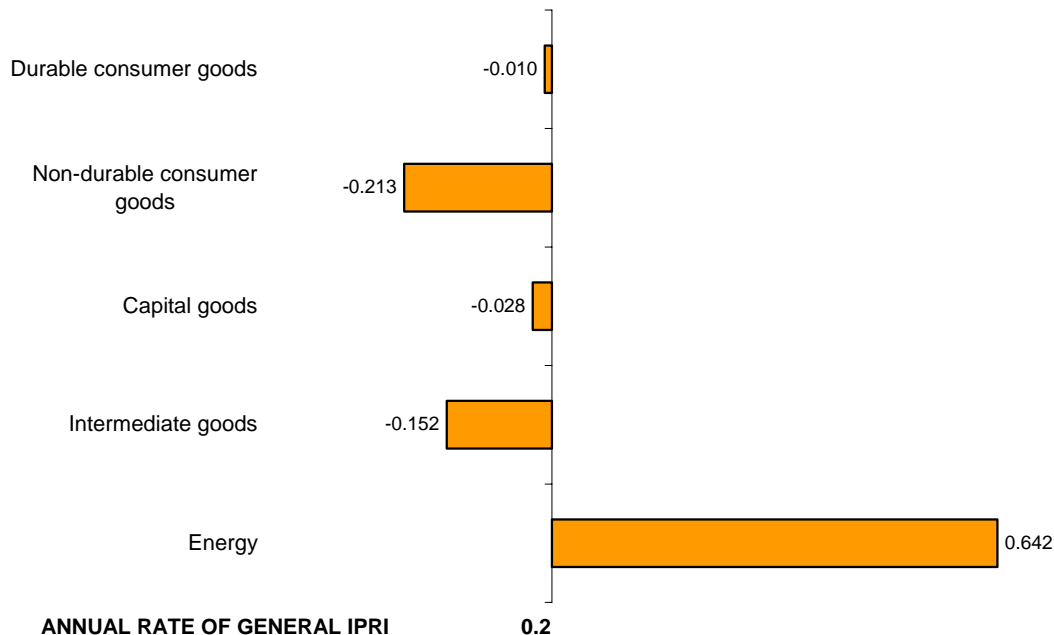
- **Energy**, whose rate stood at **1.7%**, more than two points higher than that registered in August. This increase was due to the increase in the prices of *Production, transportation and distribution of the electric power*.

Within this sector, it is worth noting the decrease in the annual rate of:

- **Non-durable consumer goods**, whose variation stood at **1.1%**, nine tenths below that of August and the lowest rate since October 2010. This drop was due to the decrease in prices of *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats* and also due to the lowest increase in the prices of *Processing and preserving of meat and manufacture of meat products*, as compared with September 2012.

• **Intermediate goods**, whose annual variation decreased six tenths standing at **-1.9%**, its lowest rate since December 2009. This behaviour was due mainly to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of feed products for animals*, as compared with the increase registered in 2012.

## Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In September, the monthly variation of the general IPRI was **2.0%**.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors with the greatest positive monthly effect in the general index were:

• **Energy**, with a monthly variation of **0.7%**, due to the increase in the prices of *Production, transportation and distribution of the electric power*. Its effect on the general IPRI was **0.206**.

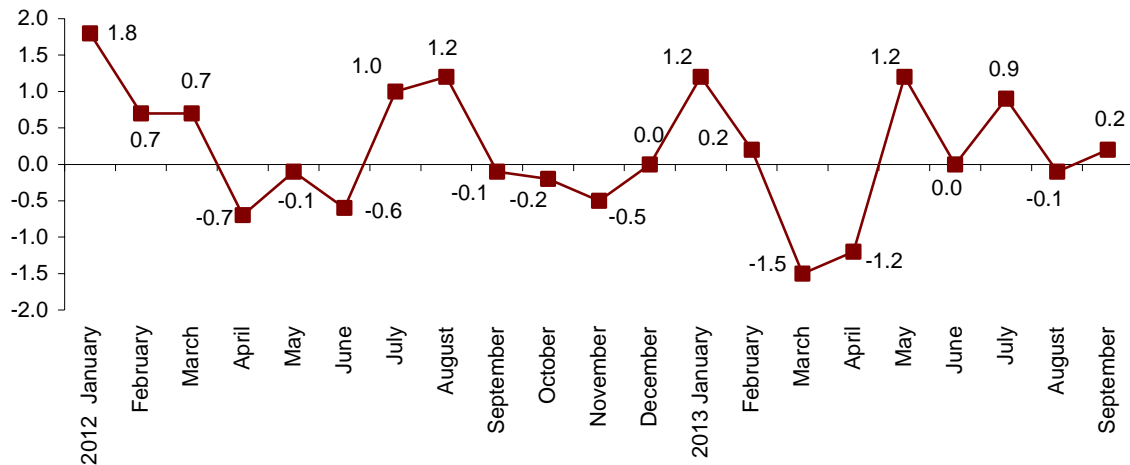
• **Non-durable consumer goods**, with a variation of **0.1%**, due to the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of dairy products* and *Processing and preserving of meat and manufacture of meat products*. Its effect on the general index was **0.025**.

In turn, the sectors registering a greatest negative monthly effect in the general index were:

• **Intermediate goods**, with a variation of **-0.2%**, and an effect of **-0.048**, reflecting the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of feed products for animals*.

• **Capital goods**, with a variation of **-0.1%** and an effect of **-0.020** due to the decrease in the prices of *Repair of metal products, machinery and equipment*.

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of September.

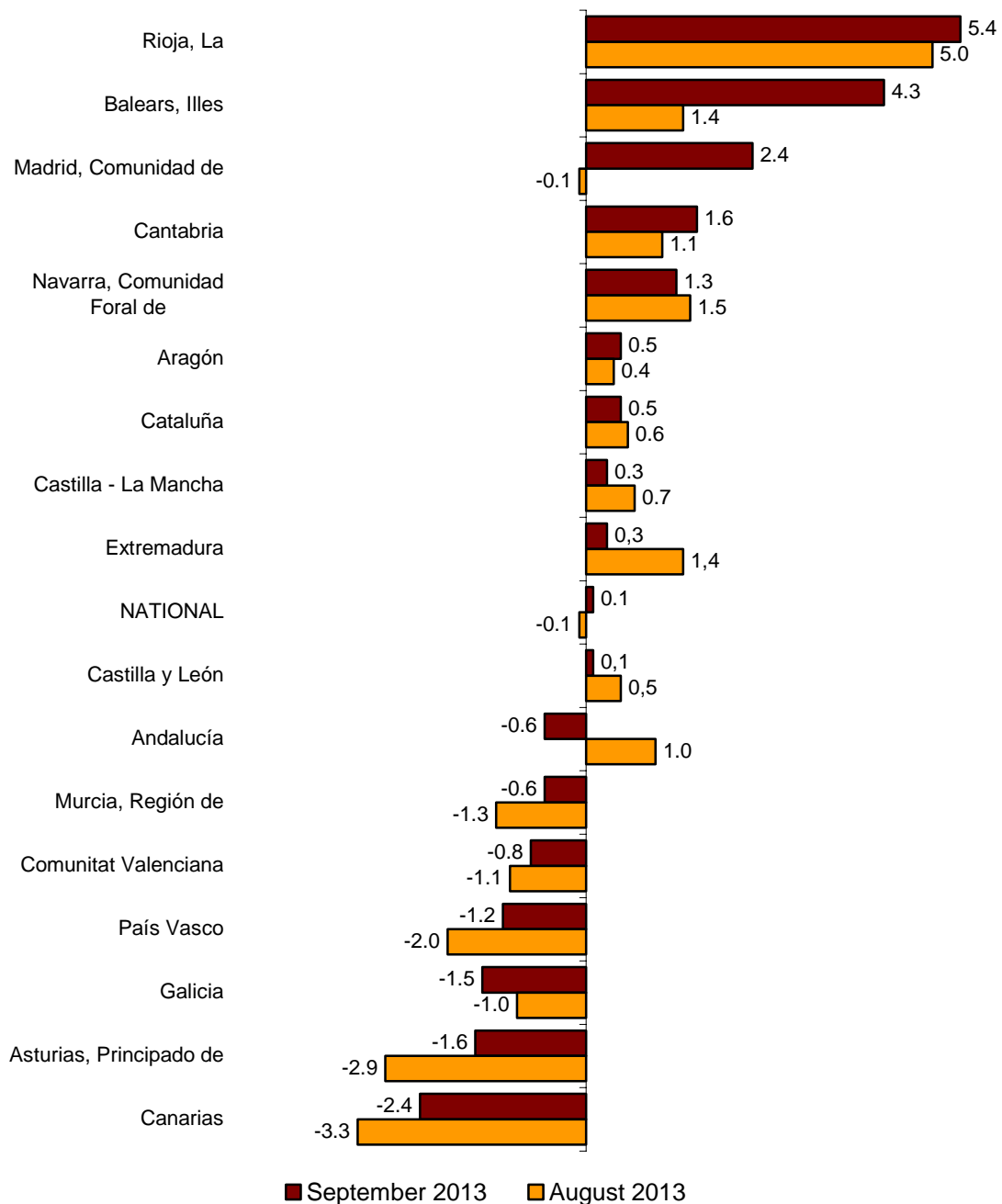
## Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

The annual rate of the IPRI increased in 10 Autonomous Communities, highlighting Illes Balears (4.3%) and Comunidad de Madrid (2.4%), with increases of 2.9 and 2.5 points, respectively.

In turn, the greatest decreases were registered in Andalucía (−0.6%) and Extremadura (0.3%), whose annual rates decreased 1.6 and 1.1 points, respectively.
