Industrial Price Index (IPRI). Base 2010 September 2013. Provisional data

The annual rate of the Industrial Price Index stands at 0.1%, two tenths over that registered in August

The monthly variation rate of the Industrial Price Index is 0.2%

Annual evolution of industrial prices

The annual rate of the Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at **0.1%** in September, two tenths over that registered in August.



By economic destination of the goods, the only industrial sector that most influenced the increase in the general rate of the IPRI was:

• *Energy*, whose rate stood at **1.7%**, more than two points higher than that registered in August. This increase was due to the increase in the prices of *Production, transportation and distribution of the electric power.*

Within this sector, it is worth noting the decrease in the annual rate of:

• **Non-durable consumer goods**, whose variation stood at **1.1%**, nine tenths below that of August and the lowest rate since October 2010. This drop was due to the decrease in prices of *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats* and also due to the lowest increase in the prices of *Processing and preserving of meat and manufacture of meat products,* as compared with September 2012.



• Intermediate goods, whose annual variation decreased six tenths standing at -1.9%, its lowest rate since December 2009. This behaviour was due mainly to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of feed products for animals*, as compared with the increase registered in 2012.



Influence of the industrial sectors in the annual rate of IPRI

Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In September, the monthly variation of the general IPRI was 2.0%.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors with the greatest positive monthly effect in the general index were:

• *Energy*, with a monthly variation of **0.7%**, due to the increase in the prices of *Production, transportation and distribution of the electric power.* Its effect on the general IPRI was **0.206**.

• **Non-durable consumer goods**, with a variation of **0.1%**, due to the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of dairy products* and *Processing and preserving of meat and manufacture of meat products*. It effect on the general index was **0.025**.

In turn, the sectors registering a greatest negative monthly effect in the general index were:

• Intermediate goods, with a variation of -0.2%, and an effect of -0.048, reflecting the decrease in the prices of Manufacture of feed products for animals.

• **Capital goods**, with a variation of **-0.1%** and an effect of **-0.020** due to the decrease in the prices of *Repair of metal products, machinery and equipment.*

Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

The annual rate of the IPRI increased in 10 Autonomous Communities, highlighting Illes Balears (4.3%) and Comunidad de Madrid (2.4%), with increases of 2.9 and 2.5 points, respectively.

In turn, the greatest decreases were registered in Andalucía (-0.6%) and Extremadura (0.3%), whose annual rates decreased 1.6 and 1.1 points, respectively.
