Industrial Price Index. 2015 Baseline

September 2023. Provisional data

The annual variation of the Industrial Price Index stands at -8.6%, one and a half points above that of August

The monthly rate of industrial prices was 1.4%

Annual evolution of industrial prices

The annual rate of the general Industrial Price Index (IPRI) was -8.6% in the month of September, almost one and a half points below that registered in August.

By the economic use of the goods, the industrial sectors with a positive influence on the evolution of the annual rate of the General IPRI are:

• **Energy**, whose variation increased by nearly three and a half points to stand at -25.7%. This behaviour is due to the increases in the prices of the *Electric power generation*, *transmission and distribution* and of the *Manufacture of refined petroleum products*, which fell in September 2022.

Also worth noting, although in the opposite direction, was that the prices of *Gas production;* pipeline distribution of gaseous fuels through mains, rose less than they did in the same month last year.


• Intermediate goods, with an annual variation of -5.3%, almost five tenths above the August figure, and caused by the increase in the prices of the *Manufacture of basic chemicals, nitrogen compounds, fertilisers, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms*, in contrast with the decrease in the same month in 2022.

On the other hand, among the industrial sectors with a negative influence, worth noting was:

• **Non-durable consumer goods**, whose rate decreased by five tenths, to 9.7%, due to the fact that the prices of *Processing and Preserving of Meat and Production of Meat Products* remained stable, whereas they increased in September last year.

Another influence, although in the opposite way, is that the prices of the *manufacture of vegetable and animal oils* and fats increased more than in September the previous year.

Contribution of industrial sectors to the annual IPRI rate




Annual rate difference IPRI -1.3

The annual variation rate of the general index excluding Energy increased by one tenth, to 1.8%, standing nearly 10 and a half points above that of the general IPRI.

Monthly evolution of industrial prices


In September, the monthly variation of the general IPRI was 1.4%.

By economic destination of goods, among the industrial sectors that presented a positive monthly impact, the following stand out:

- **Energy**, with a monthly rate of 4.3% and a contribution of 1.310, due to price increases in *Manufacture of gas; distribution of gaseous fuels through mains* and, to a lesser extent, in *Electric power generation, transmission and distribution.*
- **Non-durable consumer goods**, with a monthly rate of 0.4%, which impacted 0.103, as a consequence of the increase in the prices of the *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and flats*.

Results by Autonomous Communities. Annual variation rates


The annual rate of the IPRI increased in September in 13 Autonomous Communities, decreased in three and remained stable in the others.

The largest increases occurred in Andalucía, Canarias and Illes Balears, whose rates rose 3.8 points in the first two and 3.3 in the third of these communities.

On the other hand, the communities where the rate decreased the most were La Rioja, Cantabria and Extremadura, with falls of 0.5, 0.2 and 0.1 points, respectively.

Data Review and Update

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data of the IPRI series for the last three months, with the month of June 2023 becoming definitive. The results are available at INEBase.

Methodological note

The Industrial Price Index (IPRI) is a short-term indicator that measures the monthly evolution of the prices of industrial products manufactured and sold in the domestic market, in the first step of their commercialisation, that is to say, at ex-factory prices, excluding transport and commercialisation costs and invoiced VAT.

Type of survey: monthly continuous survey.

Base year: 2015.

Reference period of the weightings: the year preceding the current year.

Population scope: industrial establishments.

Sample size: 9,000 industrial establishments and 1,500 items.

Number of observations: approximately 28,000 monthly prices.

General calculation method: Laspeyres' Chain Index.

Collection method: internet (IRIA system), e-mail, fax, telephone or postal mail.
