#### Industrial Price Index (IPRI). Base 2005

November 2011. Provisional data

#### Main results

- The **interannual** rate of the IPRI for the month of November is **6.3%**, two tenths below than the rate registered in October.
- The **monthly** variation of the general index is **0.2%**.
- All Autonomous Communities register positive interannual rates in November.
- The Autonomous Community that records the greatest interannual variation is **Canarias**, with **10.6%**.

#### Annual evolution of industrial prices

The interannual variation of the Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at 6.3% in November, two tenths below than the rate registered in October.


By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors with the most negative effect on the general index were:

• Intermediate goods, with an interannual rate of 4.0%, one points lower than that registered in October and the lower registered since September 2010. This drop was due to the decrease in price of the Manufacture of basic chemical products, nitrogen compounds, fertilisers, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms and Manufacture of animal feed products, as compared with the increase registered November the previous year, and due to the fact that the Production of precious metals and other non-ferrous metals experienced a smaller increase in prices this year than in the 2010.

Among the activities with a positive annual influence on the general index, worth noting:

• Non-durable consumer goods, whose interannual rate increased two tenths and stood at 2.7%. This was due to that the prices of the *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products* decreased less this year than in November the previous year. Also worth noting were the increases in the prices of the *Graphic arts and related services* and the *Manufacture of beverages* in November 2011.

#### Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In November, the monthly variation of the IPRI was 0.2%.


By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sector with a positive monthly influence on the general index was:

• Energy, with a monthly rate of **0.8%**, that reflected the increases in the prices of the *Petroleum refinement*. Its effect on the general index was **0.219**.

On the other hand, worth noting that the only industrial sector with negative monthly influence on the general index was:

• Intermediate goods, whose monthly rate of -0.5% contributed -0.160 to the general index. Worth noting in this variation the decrease in prices of the *Manufacture of basic iron, steel* and ferro-alloy products, *Manufacture of basic chemical products, nitrogen compounds, fertilisers, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms* and the *Manufacture of animal feed products*.

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of November.



#### Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

In the almost Autonomous Communities the annual rate decreased in November. Conversely, Comunidad de Madrid and La Rioja increased three tenths, and stood at 6.1% and 3.4%, respectively.

In turn, the greatest decreases corresponded to Cantabria (2.6 points), Castilla-La Mancha (0.7 points), Castilla y León (0.6 points) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (0.6 points), whose rates stood at 5.0%, 7.8%, 4.0% and 4.7%, respectively.
