Unpaid Bills of Exchange Statistics (UBE)

July 2013. Provisional data

The value of unpaid bills of exchange decreases 30.9% in July, as compared with the same month of the previous year

2.6% of the total expired bills of exchange are unpaid

In July, the number of expired bills of exchange reached 15,406 million euros, 8.9% below that of the same month of 2012.


With regards to returned unpaid bills of exchange, the value reached 400 million euros, representing a 30.9% decrease as compared with the same month of 2012.

The percentage of unpaid bills of exchange as compared with expired bills of exchange reached 2.6%, almost one point below that registered in the same month of the previous year.

Percentage of unpaid bills of exchange against expired bills of exchange



In July, the total value of expired bills of exchange reached 8,308,133, that is, 4.2% less than that registered in the same month of the previous year.

The average value of expired bills of exchange reached 1,854 euros, representing a 4.9% decrease in the interannual rate. In turn, the average value of unpaid bills of exchange stood at 1,491, 13.9% less.





Monthly rate evolution

In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of data, this chart shows the variation of the unpaid and expired bills of exchange between July and June of the last five years.

The monthly variation of the expired bills of exchange (16.6%) and the monthly variation rate of the unpaid bills of exchange (2.6%), were the highest registered in the considered period.





Credit expired by type of bill

In July, 64.2% of the value of expired bills of exchange corresponded to unpaid portfolio bills of exchange and 35.8% to debt collection management from clients.

Of the total value of unpaid bills of exchange, 67.0% corresponded to portfolio bills of exchange and 33.0% to bills of exchange in debt collection management.

In July, 2.7% of the total expired bills of exchange of portfolio were unpaid. In turn, 2.4% of the total expired bills of exchange in debt collection management were unpaid.



Geographical distribution of unpaid bills of exchange

In July, the greatest annual decrease of the value of unpaid bills of exchange was registered in Cantabria (–67.3%). Cataluña and Comunidad de Madrid (both with –18.3%) registered the lowest decreases.

Annual variation of the value of unpaid bills of exchange by Autonomous Community



Extremadura (with 4.3%) was the Autonomous Community that presented the highest percentage of unpaid bills of exchange as compared with the expired bills of exchange. In turn, Comunidad Foral de Navarra registered the lowest percentage (with a 2.0%).

In July, Cataluña and Comunidad de Madrid accumulated over half of the total of unpaid bills of exchange (50.5%).
