Statistics on Transfer of Property Rights (STPR) January 2019. Provisional data

In January, 198,298 properties are registered in the land registers, 10.6% more than in the same month of the previous year


Registered housing sales decreases by 0.2%, as compared with January 2018

The number of property transfers recorded in the land registers (from previously public deeds) in January was 198,298, that is, 10.6% more than in the same month of 2018.

Regarding registered property sales, the number of transfers was 98,371, with an annual increase of 3.6%.

Sales recorded in land registers

Press

In January, 85.7% of sales registered corresponded to urban properties and 14.3% to rustic properties. Among urban properties, 56.5% were housing sales.

In January, the number of rustic properties sales increased by 2.0% in the annual rate, while that of urban properties did so by 3.8%. Within the latter, housing sales recorded an annual decrease of 0.2%.



Trend in monthly rate

In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of the data, the following chart shows the variation in the number of housing sales between the months of December and January in the last five years. In 2019, the monthly rate was 40.8%, that is, 5.6 points less than that of the previous year.

Registered housing sales, by protection system and status

In January, 89.9% of property transfers by sale were free-market dwellings and 10.1% protected dwellings.

In annual terms, the number of transfers of free-market dwellings by sale decreased by 0.9%, and that of protected dwellings increased by 6.4%.

In January, 19.4% of dwellings transferred by sale were new and 80.6% were used.


The number of transactions on new dwellings increased by 11.2%, while that on used dwellings decreased by 2.6% as compared with January 2018.

Results by Autonomous Community

Press Release

In January, the total number of property transfers recorded in the land registries per 100,000 inhabitants¹ reached its highest values in La Rioja (1,083), Castilla–La Mancha (747) and Castilla y León (703).

La Rioja (30.2%), Región de Murcia (27.2%) and Cataluña (26.6%) registered the greatest annual variation rates.

In turn, Cantabria (-11.8%), Principado de Asturias (-10.1%) and Aragón (-4.8%), registered the lowest annual rates.

As regards registered housing sales, the Autonomous Communities with the highest number of transfers per 100,000 inhabitants¹ were Comunitat Valenciana (185), La Rioja (154) and Illes Balears (151).

Properties transferred by Autonomous Community. January 2019



¹ This data have been calculated based on the provisional results of the population figures as at 01 July 2018. Only the population aged 18 to 84 years old is considered in these figures.

The Autonomous Communities that registered the greatest annual increases in the number of housing sales in January were Extremadura (36.9%), Galicia (17.5%) and Aragón (16.9%).

In turn, Canarias (-22.4%), Principado de Asturias (-18.0%) and Illes Balears (-13.7%) registered the lowest annual rates in January.

Revision and updating of data

Data for 2019 are provisional and will be reviewed when the data for the same period of the next year are published. That is, when the data for January 2020 are published, the final data for the same month in 2019 will be disseminated.

Methodological note

The Statistics on Transfer of Property Rights provide information on the number of rights on transfers of property during the reference month, on a national level, by province and Autonomous Community.

All information on transfers of property is taken from the information contained in the Land Registers for the whole country, by virtue of a partnership agreement signed in 2004 by both institutions.

Type of survey: continuous on a monthly basis

Population scope: registrations of transfers of property rights in the land registers

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, by Autonomous Community and provinces

Reference period of the results: the calendar month

Reference period of the information: the calendar month

Classification: sale, donation, inheritance, exchange and other property titles, of rustic and urban properties (dwellings, plots and other urban properties)

Collection method: administrative registers from Association of property and Mercantile registers of Spain
