Statistics on Transfer of Property Rights (STPR)
June 2020. Provisional data

In June, 112,383 properties were registered in the land registers, 33.2% less than in the same month of the previous year


Registered housing sales decreased by 34.3%, as compared with June 2019

The number of property transfers recorded in the land registers (from previously registered public deeds) was 112,383 in June; that is, 33.2% more than in the same month of 2019.

Regarding registered property sales, the number of transfers was 54,001, with a 34.2% annual decrease.

¹The heading "Other titles" includes the following items: land consolidation, horizontal divisions, joint operations or mixtures of several transfer titles, transfers without title of acquisition, dation in payment, foreclosures and court orders.

Sales recorded in land registers

In June, 86.0% of registered sales corresponded to urban properties and 14.0% to rustic properties. Among urban properties, 58.6% were housing sales.

In June, the number of rustic property sales decreased by 30.1% in the annual rate, while there was a 34.8% decrease for urban properties. Within the latter, housing sales recorded an annual decrease of 34.3%.



Trend in monthly rate

In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of the data, the following chart shows the variation in the number of housing sales between the months of May and June in the last five years. In 2020, the monthly rate was 21.6%, that is, 35.9 points more than the previous year.

Registered housing sales, by protection system and status

In June, 91.2% of dwellings transferred by sale were free-market dwellings and 8.8% were protected dwellings.

In annual terms, the number of transfers of free dwellings by merchanting decreased by 33.7%, and that of protected dwellings did so by 39.9%.

In June, 19.9% of dwellings transferred by sale were new and 80.1% were used.

The number of new home transactions fell 24.5% compared to June 2019 and that of used homes 36.4%.



Results by Autonomous Community

In June, the total number of property transfers recorded in the land registries per 100,000 inhabitants¹ reached its highest values in Castilla y León (519), La Rioja (455) and Cantabria (402).

País Vasco (-8.7%), Galicia (-11.1%) and Cantabria (-12.1%) registered the least negative annual variation rates.

In turn, Aragón (-51.8%), Comunidad de Madrid (-42.7%) and Canarias (-42.0%), registered the lowest annual rates.

As regards registered housing sales, the Autonomous Communities with the highest number of transfers per 100,000 inhabitants¹ were Región de Murcia (103), Cantabria, Comunitat Valenciana and La Rioja (all 87).



¹ This data have been calculated based on the provisional results of the population figures as at 01 January 2020. Only the population aged 18 to 84 years old is considered in these figures.

All the communities showed negative annual rates in the number of dwellings sold in June. The lowest decreases occurred in La Rioja (-8.9%), País Vasco (-12.4%) and Extremadura (-14.2%).

In turn, Canarias (-41.8%), Comunitat Valenciana (-43.9%) and Galicia (-44.8%) registered the largest decreases.

Revision and updating of data

Data for 2020 is provisional and will be reviewed when the data for the same period of the next year is published. In other words, when the data for June 2021 are published, the final data for the same month of 2020 will be disseminated.

Methodological note

The Statistics on Transfer of Property Rights provide information on the number of rights on transfers of property during the reference month, on a national level, by province and Autonomous Community.

All information on transfers of property is taken from the information contained in the Land Registers for the whole country, by virtue of a partnership agreement signed in 2004 by both institutions.

Type of survey: continuous on a monthly basis

Population scope: registrations of transfers of property rights in the land registers

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, by Autonomous Community and provinces

Reference period for the results: the calendar month

Reference period for the information: the calendar month

Classification: sale, donation, inheritance, exchange and other property titles, of rustic and urban properties (dwellings, plots and other urban properties)

Collection method: administrative registers from Association of property and Mercantile registers of Spain
