## Statistics on Transfer of Property Rights (STPR) September 2022. Provisional data


**In September, the number of property transfers registered is 175,374 properties, that is, 2.1% less than in the same month of the previous year**

**Registered housing sales increases by 6.9%, as compared with September 2021**

The number of property transfers recorded in the land registries (from public deeds previously registered) was 175,374 in September, that is, 2.1% less than in the same month of 2021.

Regarding registered property sales, the number of transfers was 102,987, with an annual increase of 0.1%.

## Sales recorded in land registers

88.7% of sales registered in September corresponded to urban properties and 11.3% to rustic properties. Among urban properties, 62.7% were housing sales.

In September, the number of rustic property sales dropped by 11.1% in the annual rate while that of urban properties rose by 1.7%. Within the latter, housing sales recorded an annual increase of 6.9%.



## Trend in monthly rate

In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of the data, the following chart shows the variation in the number of housing sales between the months of August and September in the last five years. The monthly rate in 2022 was 0.0%, or 7.5 points less than that of the previous year.

## Registered housing sales, by protection system and status

92.4% of dwellings transferred by sale in September were free dwellings, and 7.6% were protected dwellings.

In annual terms, the number of free dwellings transferred by sale increased by 7.4%, and that of protected dwellings by 1.4%.

17.5% of the dwellings transferred by sale in September were new, and 82.5% were used.


The number of new home transactions rose 7.8% compared to September 2021, while that of used homes rose by 10.7%.

## Registered housing sales, according to transferor and owner

The number of housing sales between physical persons in September was 40,148, that is, 1.8% more than in the same month of 2021.

## Results by Autonomous Community

In September, the total number of property transfers recorded in the land registers per 100,000 inhabitants<sup>1</sup> reached its highest values in La Rioja (769), Castilla y León (749) and Aragón (698).

Canarias (12.0%), Extremadura (7.5%) and La Rioja (4.3%) registered the highest annual variation rates.

In turn, Comunidad Foral de Navarra (-13.3%), Illes Balears (-12.8%) and Cantabria (-12.0%) registered the lowest annual rates.

With regard to registered housing sales, the Autonomous Communities with the highest number of transfers per 100,000 inhabitants<sup>1</sup> were Comunitat Valenciana (226), Andalucía (170) and Región de Murcia (169).


<sup>1</sup> This data have been calculated based on the provisional results of the population figures as at 01 January 2022. Only the population aged 18 to 84 years old is considered in these figures.

The Autonomous Communities that registered the greatest annual increases in the number of housing sales in September were Canarias (35.5%), Extremadura (27.2%) and Aragón (18.4%).

On the other hand, the number of purchases decreased in Comunidad Foral de Navarra (-21.9%), Comunidad de Madrid (-4.8%) and Andalucía (-2.2%).

### **Revision and updating of data**

Data for 2022 is provisional and will be reviewed when the data for the same period of the next year is published. In other words, when the data for September 2023 is published, the final data for the same month of 2022 will be disseminated.

## **Methodological note**

The Statistics on Transfer of Property Rights provide information on the number of rights on transfers of property during the reference month, on a national level, by province and Autonomous Community.

All information on transfers of property is taken from the information contained in the Land Registers for the whole country, by virtue of a partnership agreement signed in 2004 by both institutions.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, by Autonomous Community and provinces

**Reference period for the results:** the calendar month

**Classification:** sale, donation, inheritance, exchange and other property titles, of rustic and urban properties (dwellings, plots and other urban properties)

**Collection method:** administrative registers from Association of property and Mercantile registers of Spain
