Residents Travel Survey (RTS/FAMILITUR)

First quarter, year 2021.

The number of trips made by residents in Spain decreased 47.8% in the first quarter of 2021 and stands at 15.2 million

Total expenditure decreased by 64.9% reaching 2,260 million euros

Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana are the main destinations

Residents in Spain made 15.2 million trips in the first quarter of 2021, 47.8% less than for the same period in 2020.

The main destination of 96.9% of the trips was within the national territory, with a decrease of 43.6% as compared to the first quarter of last year. On the other hand, trips abroad, which represent 3.1% of the total, decreased by 84.4%.



By weeks¹, a decrease in trips was observed throughout the quarter, except in the last three weeks of March (where it was compared with the confinement period of 2020).

¹ In order to study trips by return date, trips to workplaces and centres of study were excluded (13.4% of the trips in the quarter) Also note that the last week of the third and fourth quarters of the graph have eight days, to complete the days in the quarter.

Trips according to purpose, accommodation and main transport

Among domestic trips, *Visits to family or friends*, which were the primary reason for 45.8% of trips made in the first quarter, decreased by 38.8%. In turn, trips for *Leisure*, *recreation and holidays*, which represented 26.6% of the total, registered an annual decrease of 61.6%.

Trips for *Business and other professional reasons* decreased by 11.2%, and those made for *Other reasons*² decreased by 26.4%.

In trips abroad, the main motivation is *Visits to family or friends*, with 48.4% of the total and an annual decrease of 75.1%.

In 50.1% of domestic trips, residents stayed in family or friends' dwellings. More than 7.3 million trips used this type of accommodation, with an annual decrease of 41.1%.

For trips abroad, non-market accommodation was the preferred option (51.1 % of trips). This type of accommodation registered a decrease of 76.8% as compared with the first quarter of 2020.

As for the main type of transport used, own vehicles accounted for 85.4% of domestic trips, 37.6% less than in the same quarter of 2020.

In 46.4% of the trips abroad, air transport was used, with a decrease of 89.9%. Travel in a personal vehicle and in other types of transport accounted for 53.6% of trips, with a decrease of 70.9%.

Main destinations

The main destination Autonomous Communities for trips by residents in the first quarter of 2021 were Cataluña (with 15.7% of the total), Andalucía (14.4%) and Comunitat Valenciana (12.6%).

If domestic trips are correlated with the destination population, travel is more intense in Castilla y León (with 541 trips per 1,000 inhabitants), Aragón (495) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (453).



Autonomous Communities of origin

Trips made by the residents in Cataluña represented 17.3% of the total in the first quarter. This was followed by Andalucia (14.9%) and Comunitat Valenciana (13.1%).



Removing the effect caused by each Autonomous Community's size, those travelling the most were from Castilla y León (532 trips per 1,000 inhabitants³), Canarias (453) and Comunidad de Navarra (443).

In turn, those who travel less are the residents in Region de Murcia (186 trips per 1,000 inhabitants), País Vasco (203) and Comunidad de Madrid (272).

Travel expenses

The total travel expenditure in the first quarter reached 2,260 million euros, indicating an 64.9% decrease as compared with the same period of 2020.

In trips to domestic destinations, total expenditure fell by 54.1% and in those made abroad by 84.7%.

The average daily expenditure was 43 euros for domestic trips and 51 euros for trips abroad.

For domestic trips, *other expenses*, which represented the highest percentage of total expenditure (30.2%), decreased by 41.4% as compared with the first quarter of 2020.

On trips abroad, *Expenditure on transport* represented 38.5% of the total, with an annual increase of 83.8%.



According to the main Autonomous Community of destination, the highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips made to Comunidad de Madrid (52 euros), Illes Balears (49) and Canarias (49).

In turn, the lowest average daily expenditure were in Comunitat Valenciana (32 euros), Castilla y León (37) and Galicia (38 euros).


Average daily expenditure per person according to destination First quarter of 2021



By Autonomous Community of origin, the highest average daily expenditure was made by residents of Principado de Asturias (53 euros), Castilla-La Mancha (51), and Galicia (48).

In turn, the lowest values were in Comunitat Valenciana (36 euros), La Rioja (39) and Andalucia and Aragón (42 euros).

Monthly data

In January, 4.9 million trips were made, in February 4.3 million and in March 6.0 million. The trips made in January had an average duration of 4.5 overnight stays, exceeding the duration of trips in February and March, which were 2.9 and 2.8 nights, respectively.

January is the month with the lowest percentage of trips within the Autonomous Community of residence (71.9%, compared to 77.2% in February and 79.2% in March). This was due both to the higher percentage of trips to other Autonomous Community (23.5% of the total) and abroad (4.6%).

Visits to family or friends was the main reason for traveling in the months of January, February and March, with 52.2%, 45.5% and 40.9% respectively. Trips for professional reasons reached a peak in February (21.4% of the total).

January was the most important month for non-market accommodation (76.3%). Hotel accommodations and other market accommodations recorded their highest weight in March, with 17.3% and 12.4%, respectively.

Excursions

The resident population aged 15 years or older took 36.4 million excursions⁴ in the first quarter of 2021, with an annual decrease of 19,7%. 96.6% of excursions were made for personal reasons and 3.4% for professional reasons.

97.2% of the excursions were made within the Autonomous Community of residence, with an annual decrease of 13.4%.

2.7% of excursions were to another Autonomous Community and 0.1% to foreign countries. The number of excursions dropped by 75.2% in the former and by 94.9% in those with destinations abroad.

⁴ An excursion is considered any visit without an overnight stay outside the person's usual environment. Trips that are part of someone's normal routine are excluded, as are those made from second homes, from a cruise ship, or from any other accommodation other than the usual one.

Methodological note

The main objective of the Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR) is to provide information on the trips and excursions carried out each month by the population resident in Spain, both within the country and abroad, and their main characteristics (duration, expenditure, reason, accommodation, etc.).

In addition, the survey provides annual information on the percentage of the population travelling for personal reasons and investigates the reasons given by those who do not travel.

Type of operation: quarterly continuous survey.

Population scope: Resident population aged 15 and over in family dwellings (indirect information regarding trips taken by children under 15 is also provided).

Geographical scope: the entire national territory.

Reference period of the results: month, quarter, year (depending on the variable and the degree of disaggregation).

Sample size: the effective monthly sample is around 8,200 persons, who provide information on the trips completed in the two months prior to the interview. Thus, the results of a reference month are obtained from around 16,400 questionnaires.

Type of sampling: stratified two-stage random sampling. The framework is the set of main dwellings that have collaborated in the Continuous Household Survey (CHS). In each stratum of the CHS, the first stage units are the main family dwellings and the second stage units are the persons aged 15 and over residing in these dwellings. A variable defining the household's propensity to travel is used as a stratification criterion.

The selected persons collaborate three times in alternate months over six months, leave the sample one semester, and are interviewed another three times during the following semester.

Collection method: computer-assisted telephone or personal interviews, online questionnaire (since 2018).
